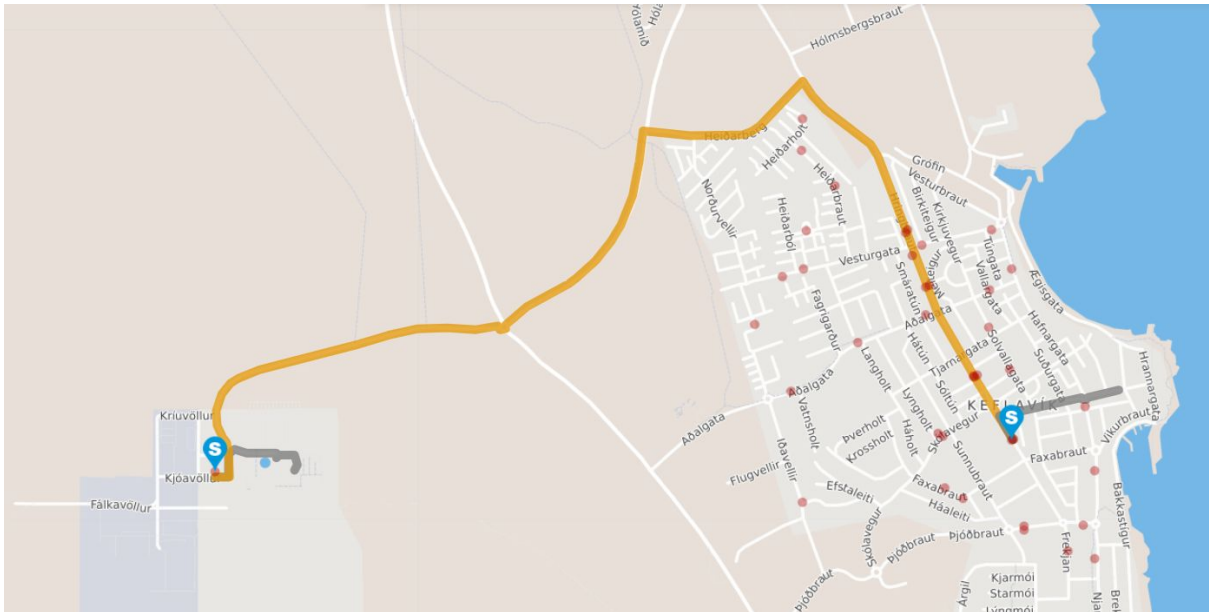

### Transport from and to the airport

Since the town of Keflavík, and our venue Hótel Keflavík, is only about 4 kilometers away from the airport, it is easy to find transport of any sort:

- **Taxi:** the trip should cost appr. kr. 2500.
- **Bus:** Route 55 takes off from the arrival hall at the airport and stops at ‘Hringbraut / Knattspyrnuvöllur’, which is within 10 minutes walking distance from the hotel. Below you can see the route and the time of departure on weekdays, Saturdays and Sundays (please note that this timetable could change, more info on [straeto.is](http://straeto.is) where you can also buy tickets):
