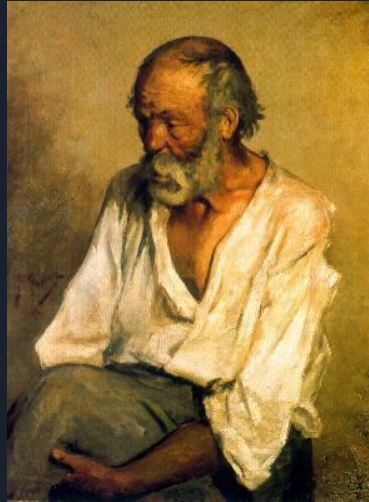


The Life and Art of Pablo Picasso

Who was Pablo Picasso?

- Pablo Picasso is one of the most famous artists in the world
 - He is famous for his doodles and drawings, he loved to draw!
 - He could draw very well but these weren't his most famous pieces
 - He liked to draw things in a way that was different from how they looked in real life.
- These paintings and drawings were his most famous



About Pablo Picasso

- Pablo Picasso was born October 25, 1881
- He was born in Malaga, Spain
- Picasso died in 1973, he was 91 years old!
- His father was a painter and an art teacher
- His full name is Pablo Diego José Francisco de Paula Juan Nepomuceno Maria de los Remedios Cipriana de la Santísima Trinidad Ruiz y Picasso
- He made over 1.800 paintings and 1.200 sculptures
- Picasso got married twice and had 4 children.



Blue and Rose Periods

The Blue period

- He was very sad at this time because a friend passed away
- His pictures were sad and had a lot of blue in them



The Rose Period

- He fell in love and his paintings changed
- His pictures were happier and had warmer colors

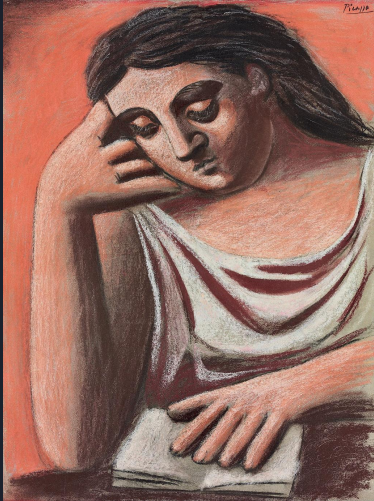
Cubism

- Picasso and a friend invented this style of painting together
- The people and things in the pictures are broken up into pieces and put back together in a different place.



Neoclassical Style

- For a little while Picasso painted with a more classical style
- Many of these paintings looked like sculptures



Surrealism

- These pictures don't make sense
- They look like something you might see in a dream or nightmare
- One of his most famous paintings was surrealist style-La Guernica



La Guernica

- A HUGE painting against the war in Spain, shows a city in the war
- People and animals in war and is a symbol for peace
- Blue, black, and white
- 11 feet by 26.6 feet
- It's in the Prado museum in Madrid!
