Topics discussed :

The fact there were no stickers on the car to exhibit it in town.

We also checked each partner had the same goals : The project is a « collaborative work ». The car is a means of achieving the educational goals.

The result of cooperative works made by the students has to be posted on the twinspace by the hosting team. Some works such as the cultural ones will end in the car by 2017.

Car body painting :

The students voted in February 2015 during the French meeting. The vote of the students must be respected. A few improvements will be added by the car body making teachers.

It was agreed that the three flags must be painted on the bonnet before the Bulgarian meeting in October 2015.

The Bulgarian flag will be painted on top of the bonnet, the French one on the right side and the Italian one on the left side.

Technical features:

Each team must list the technical questions they want to ask Renault.

Cultural aspects:

Slide shows about the visits of the Sassi have been made by students. . The Italian team will post them on the twinspace.

For future meetings, cultural activities must be planned so as to have films or works that are intended to be in the tabs which will be on the Zoé.

It was also agreed that the teachers had to invite the students to go on the Twinspace before Easter holidays to write a comment to decide which film about The Battle of Normandy is the best.

The French team will bring the tablets to the other meetings : activities with photos and films can be planned.

A Youtube account to store the films of all activities (not only cultural) has been created. The username and the password was send to the teachers involved in the project by mail on the twinspace.

French Team's wishes :

This first meeting abroad for the French team had raised a few questions. They wish they were answered before the next one in Bulgaria so that the trip be easier for the participants.

Questions :- what are the various partnerships ?

Ex : Renault : What type of partnership? Is it possible to meet Renault's engineers to know if the car can be modified ? Improved ? If it is modified, will it still be possible to drive it on the road ?

- Management of the tablets : it must be improved. Should we give them to the students every day or for the whole week ?
- Should a French student only be responsible for a tablet? Why not a Bulgarian, an Italian?
- Before going, create a chart with the students' names and the tablet number.
- Before going, French students and teachers should be trained to use them so as not to waste time while using them during the activities.

French, Italian, Bulgarian Teams' wishes :

We find it necessary to have a better communication between the teachers, the headmasters, the leaders of the project and the teams who are sent to the foreign countries.
