Loch Lomond is the largest lake in Scotland with an area of about 71 km². It stretches 39 km north-south, is up to 8 km wide and up to 190 m deep

In Loch Lomond you can even bathe but beware: the water is quite cold... there are also several rentals for example boat rentals

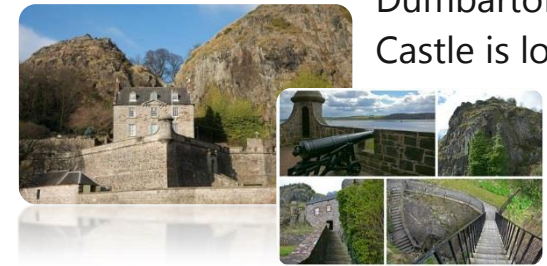
