CREATION IDEA

1938, by Lithuania nobles and Šiauliai Jewish community

OPENING OF THE SCHOOL

30 August 1851

- It was formerly a boys' school, composed of 297 students in the first year, and which had no restriction concerning the age of the students.
- The majority of the teachers was Russian and the teaching was in the Russian language as well.

During the First World War, the school was working as a German military hospital and it had its buildings severely damaged.

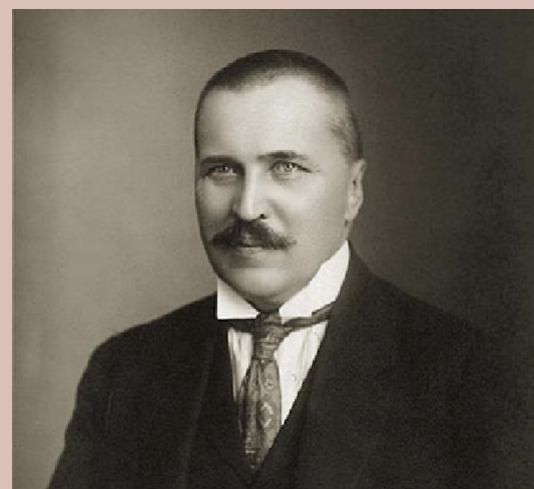
THE SCHOOL NAME

The current school name, Šiaulių Juliaus Janonio Gimnazija, comes from a famous Lithuanian poet, Julius Janonis, who attended the school around 1915. However, it was only in 1946 that the school got his name.

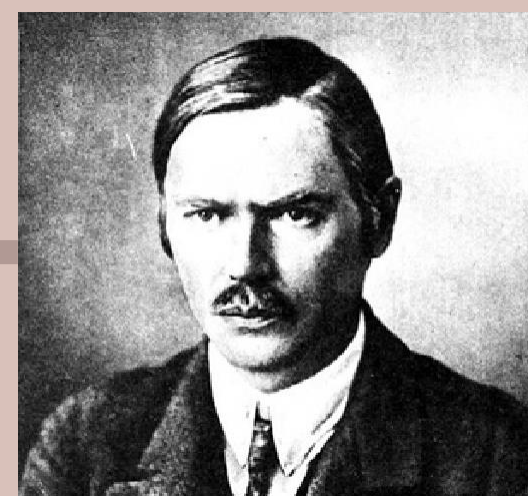

9th to 10th grade

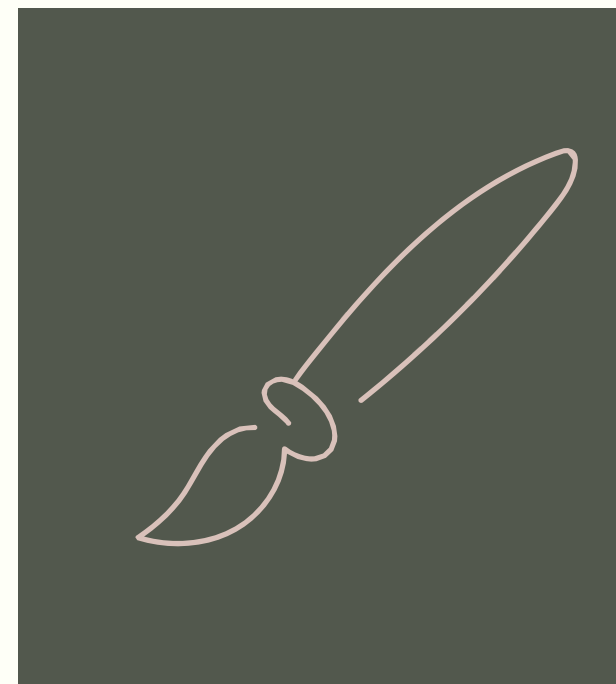
Students have all of the subjects.

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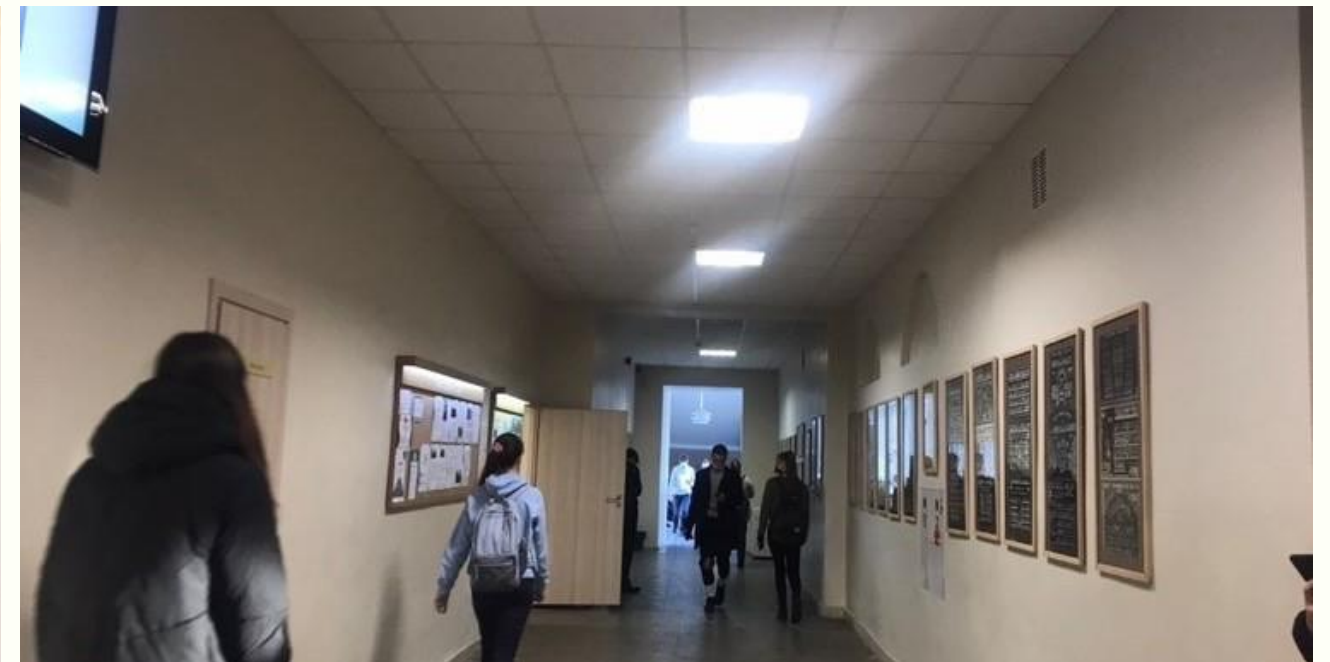

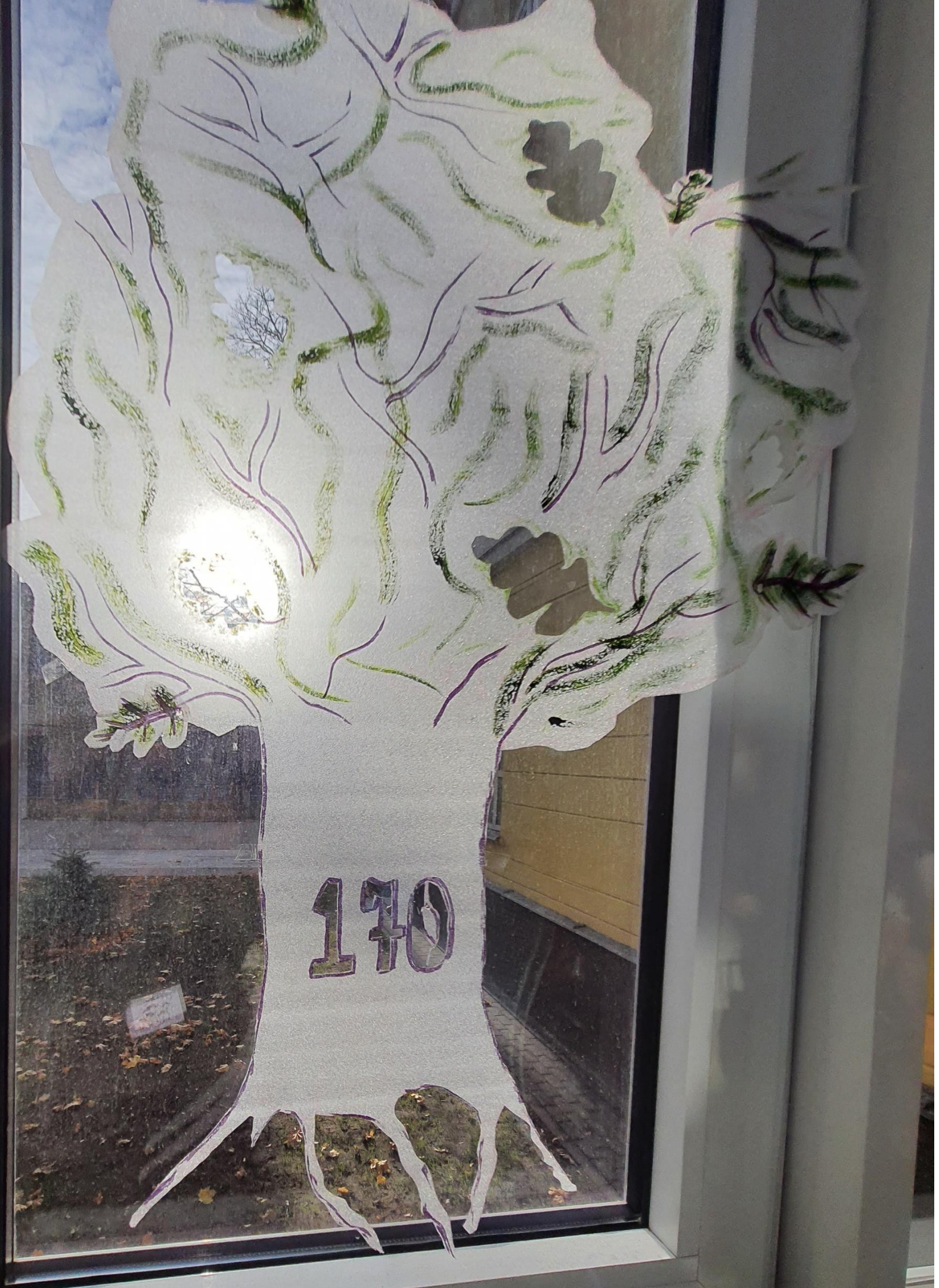

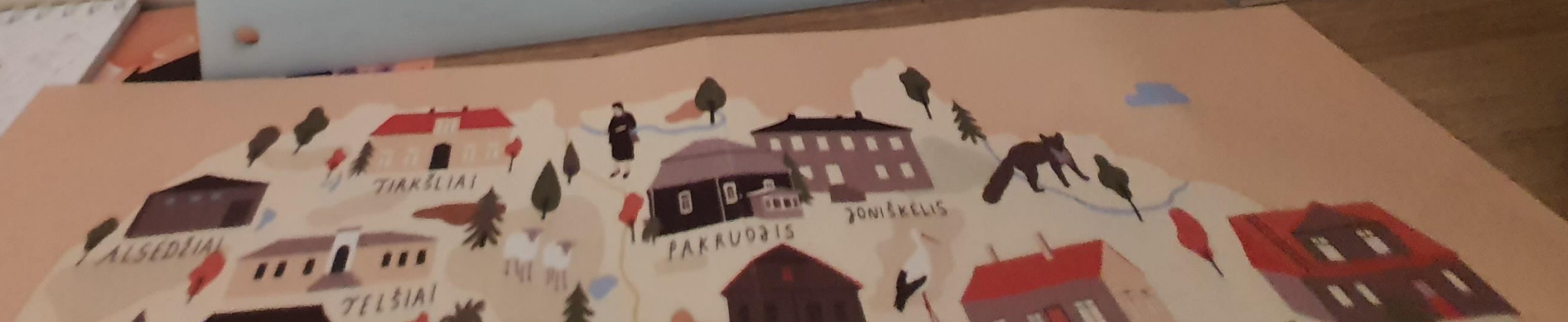
