30 August 1851

- It was formerly a boys' school, composed of 297 students in the first year, and which had no restriction concerning the age of the students.
- The majority of the teachers was Russian and the teaching was in the Russian language as well.

## DURING WORLD WARI

During the First World War, the school was working as a German military hospital and it had its buildings severely damaged.

## THE SCHOOL NAME

The current school name, Šiaulių Juliaus Janonio Gymnazija, comes from a famous Lithuanian poet, Julius Janonis, who attended the school around 1915. However, it was only in 1946 that the school got his name.
