

Motivation/Commitment Letter - Instructions

Erasmus+ Project: “+ Participatory Democracy, + Active Citizenship”

The letter of motivation/commitment will be a means of selection for participants in Erasmus+ mobilities, so answer the questions simply and concisely:

- What is it for you to be European?
- How important is collaborative work in different languages?
- What impacts on your personal and professional life of being EU citizen?
- How do you intend to apply the skills learned in this project in your life and school, mostly to enhance the students' participation?

Introduce some elements of your non-formal resume and participation in other projects that may help us to get to know you better.

For example:

- Volunteering - do you do it?
- School-level projects in which you have already participated.
- Top hobbies? - cinema, reading, sports
- If you have ever traveled to the EU, indicate which countries you know and in what context was this trip (family, school, sport ...)

Finally

- Write a final sentence that summarizes everything you said.

- ✓ The letter must be written in Portuguese and English and must not exceed 2 A4 pages (600 words).
- ✓ The two motivation/commitment letters (Portuguese and English translation) in digital format, PDF and Word, should follow the template attached to this email and should be sent by email to 450@aeccb.pt, by October 7th, by 23:59h.
- ✓ Failure to present one of the letters and/or send it after the deadline invalidates the student's choice.
