Turkey Between 1960-1970

*May 27, 1960 was made the first military coup in Turkey.

*Prime Minister Adnan Menderes and Finance Minister Hasan Polatkan were executed.

*Strike, Lockout and Collective Bargaining Law passed in 1963




Turkey Between 1970-1980

*1974 July 20, 1974 State of the Republic of Turkey has carried out the Cyprus Operation.



*On the morning of 20 July 1974, the Turkish Army's , Navy and Air Forces began airborne and landing in Cyprus.

*July 22 evening of Turkey in 1974, has accepted the UN Security Council ceasefire resolution.



Turkey Between 1980-1990

*The economic stability program prepared by the IMF was announced to the public on January 24, 1980.


*The Army took the control of management of Turkey on 12 September 1980.

*Süleyman Demirel's government was dismissed, Grand National Assembly of Turkey was abolished, Turkey began a redesign of politics.



*President Kenan Evren was elected as the 7th President.

*Turgut Özal was elected president on November 9, 1989, despite the opposition of the SHP and DYP.



Turkey Between 1990-2000

*Demirel established the DYP-SHP coalition government on 20 November 1991. SHP President Erdal İnönü was appointed as the Deputy Prime Minister.

*The law, which was enacted during the September 12 period, preventing the reopening of political parties with the same name, was abolished in June 1992.



*Upon the death of President Turgut Özal on 17 April 1993, Süleyman Demirel was elected President on 16 May 1993.

*Tansu Çiller was elected Chairman of the Board on 13 June 1993. On June 14, Süleyman Demirel gave Tansu Çiller the task of forming the 50th government.

*In November 1998, the mayor of Istanbul Metropolitan Municipality Recep Tayyip Erdogan was elected as mayor.



Turket Between 2000-2010

*It was established under the chairmanship of the 58th government of the AK Party, Abdullah Gül, who came to power with 34% of the votes in the 2002 elections.



Turkey Between 2010-2020

*In the 2011 elections, the AK Party entered the Parliament with 327 deputies, with 49.83%. The AK Party government came to power for the third time.

*In the 2011 general elections for the 2014 presidential election, when the sum of valid votes they received is calculated together, political parties exceeding ten percent were able to nominate joint candidates. Each political party could only make an offer for one candidate.



*On 15th July 2016, at around 21.30, a military coup attempt was carried out by a group of soldiers within the Turkish Armed Forces who defined themselves as the Council of Peace at Home.
