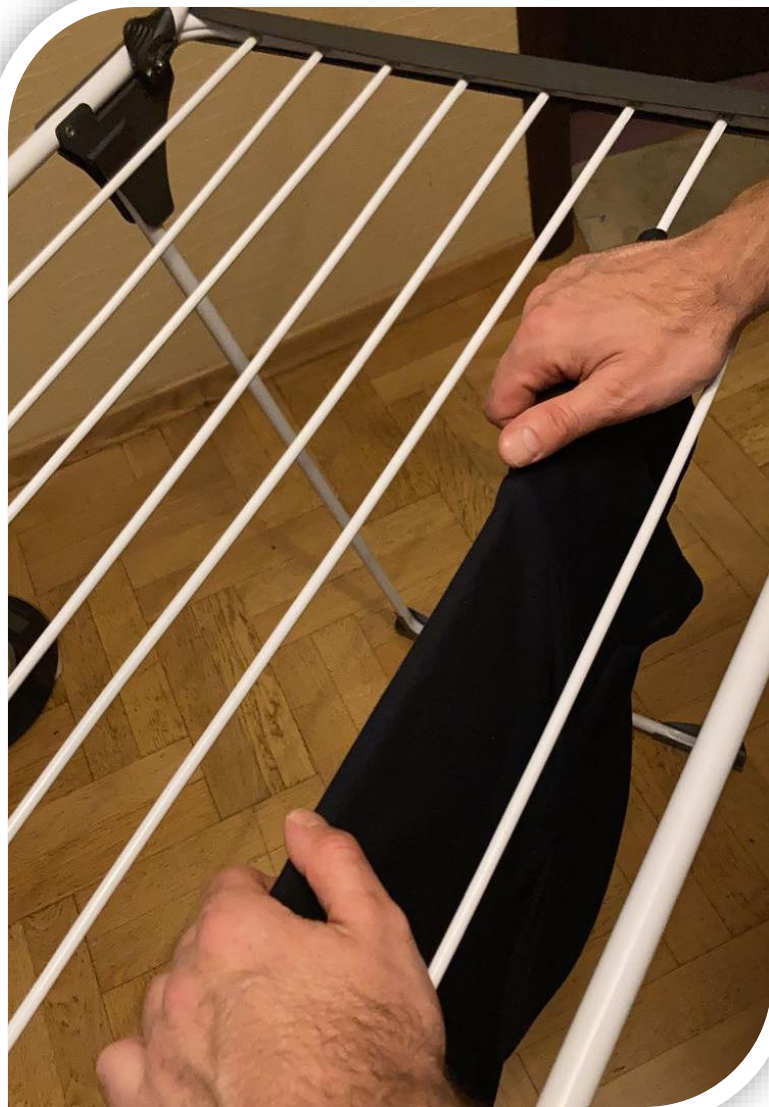
Cleaning
