### The pilatimages

The pilgrimages are the most representative festivals of the island. People dress with traditional clothes, eat and give typical food and they dance traditional music like "folias", "isas" etc.





### Most Important pilgrimages

- Tegueste pilgrimage: Celebrated on the last Sunday of April
- Los Realejos pilgrimage: It has been declared a Festival of National Tourist Interest. It is celebrated at the end of May.

### De la Cruz celebration

It is celebrated in many municipalities on the 3 of May. It consists of decorating crosses with flowers and other elements.



### Corpus Christi

The Corpus Christi is celebrated between the months of May and June. It consists of making a religious drawing on the ground made with volcanic sand of the Teide.





### HOLY WEEK

Holy Week in Spain is celebrated with the exit to the street of processions organized by brotherhoods or fraternities.

Some specific celebrations have received International or National Tourist Interest recognition.
