

## JULIO CÉSAR

Julius Caesar was born in Rome on July 12/13rd 100 B.c, he was a Roman dictator who before served as “prestura” and after he became caesar, he was killed by some senators and some of his trusted men in the senate on March 15th. After that some of his followers started a civil war that they won and they killed Julius Caesar’s murderers.

Talking about his relationship with Seville, we have to say that he came to the city twice, the second time he came, he gave to the city the name of “Colonia Iulia Romula Hispalis ” also known as Hispalis between the years 678-65 B.c. He also became benefactor of the city because he remodeled the main walls and turrets of the city but that happened the first time he came to the city, because of enlarge the city, Hispalis got able to become the big metropolis in the south of Hispania.

It’s also said that he had a relationship with a woman from the city, called Syoma Julia and with her he had two kids, but he sacrificed his firstborn to get protection from the gods and he buried him under the “Arco de la Macarena”. After this Syoma hid her second son and she changed his name, it’s said that the name he got was Bruto who will murder his father years later.

Because of this history, there are some monuments in Seville in memory of Julius Caesar, like a statue in San Francisco’s square.
