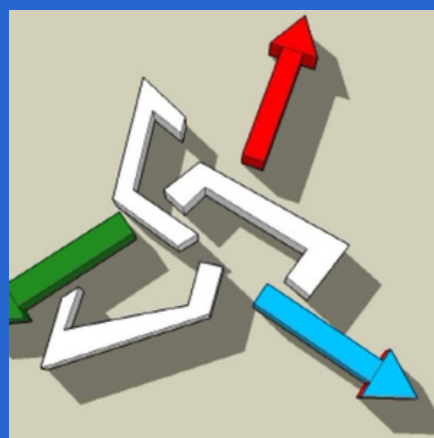


# Greek mobility

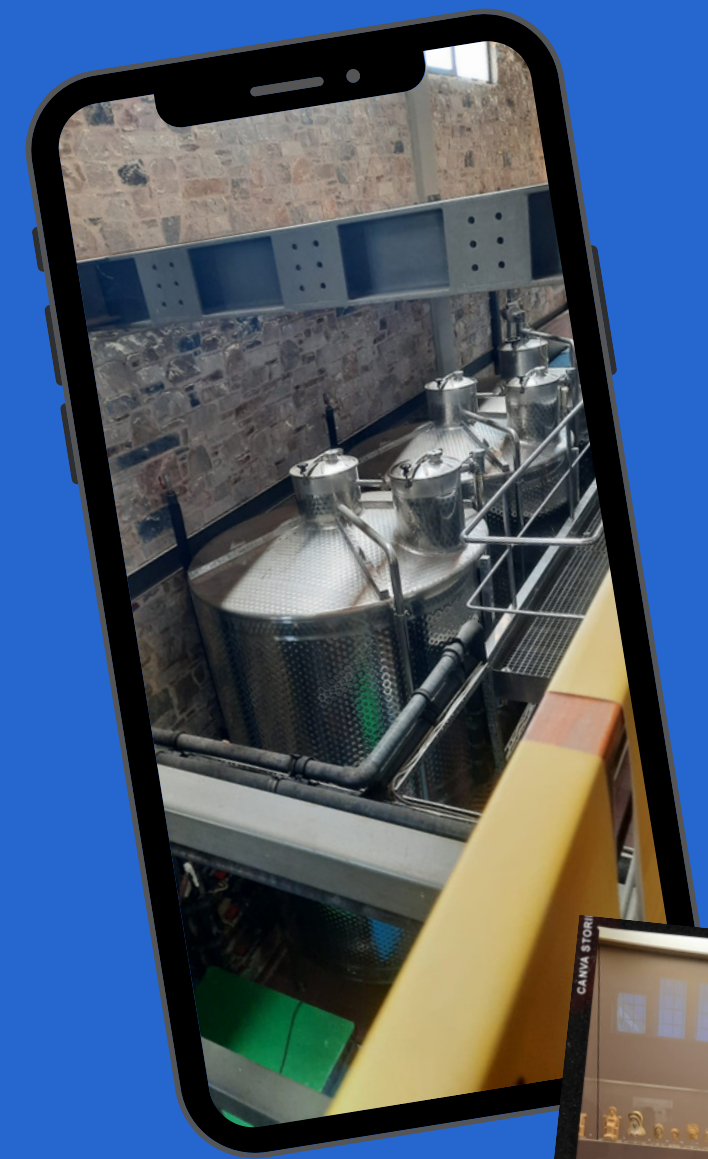




# Wednesday
