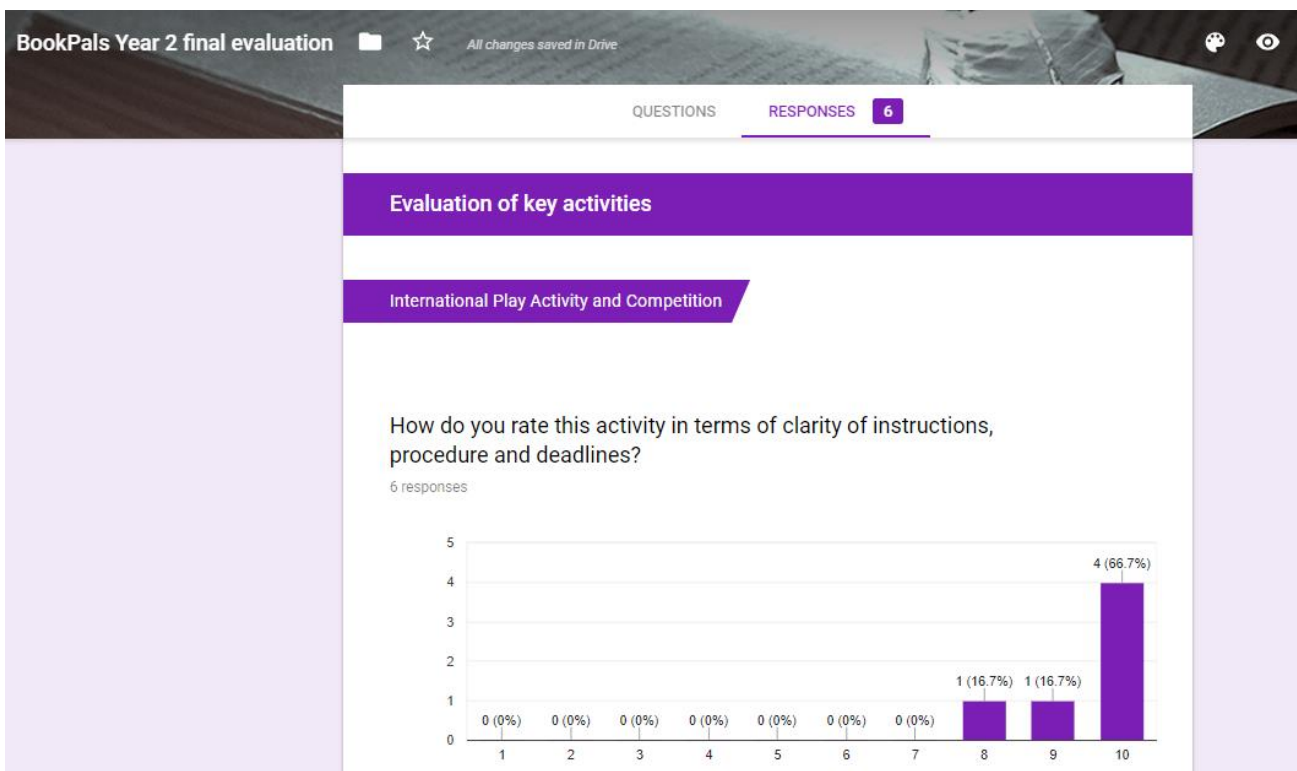

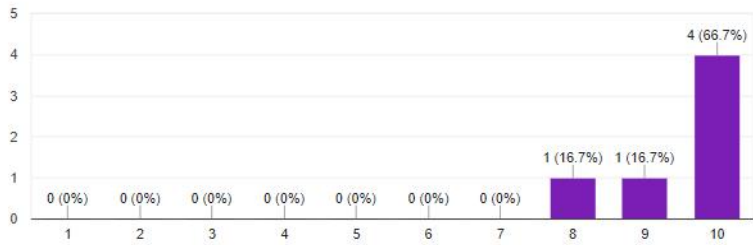

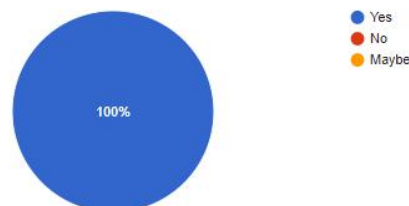

We carried out some activities in the school and we saw that the teachers asked us suggestions to read more books .

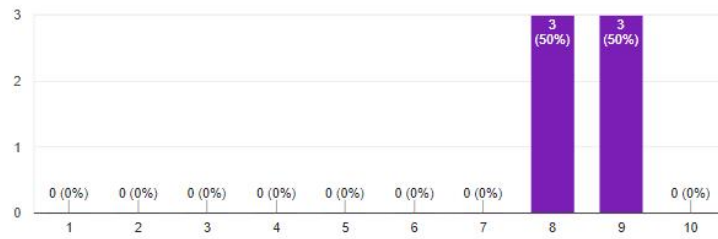
Our school librarian informed the project team about statistics of increased reading activity, therefore we plan to work on similar activities/projects in the future.

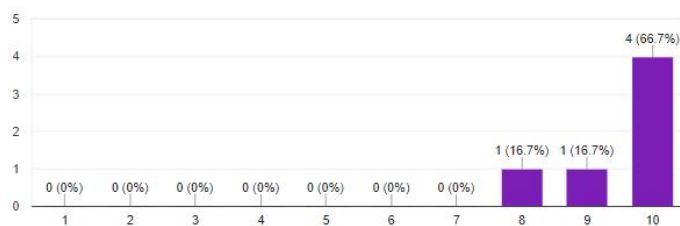

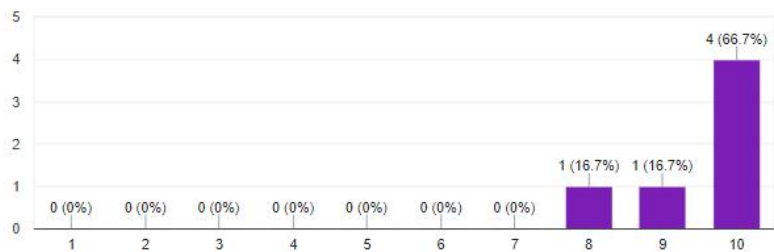

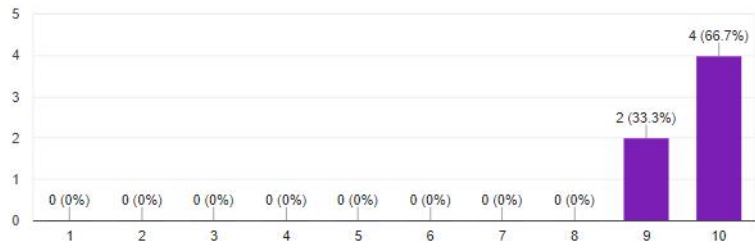

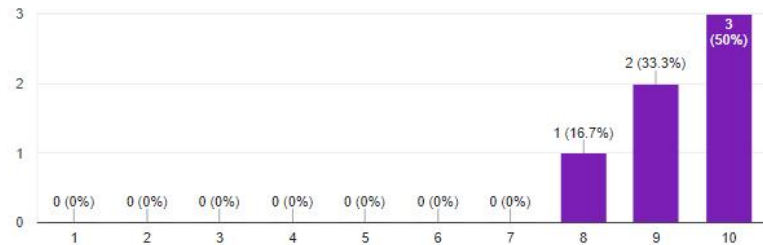

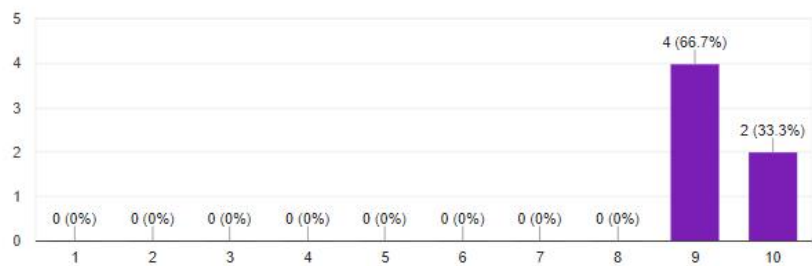

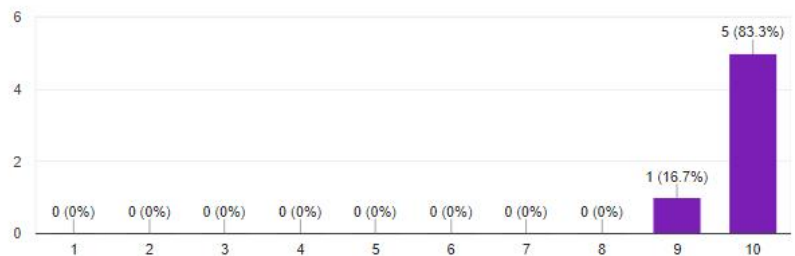

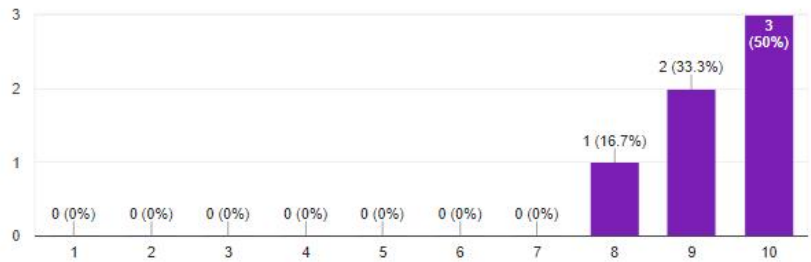

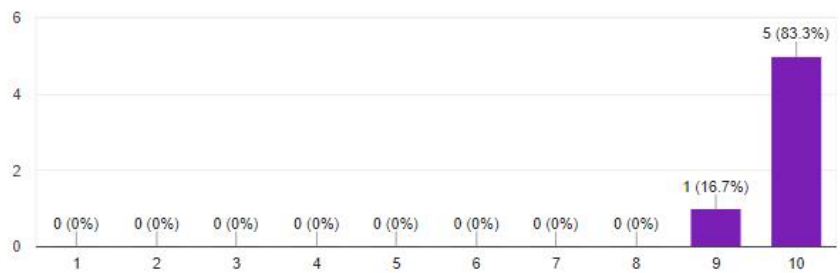
