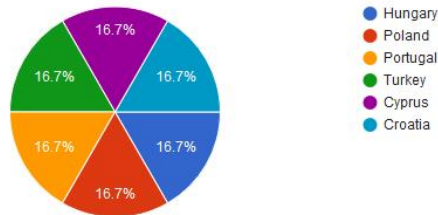

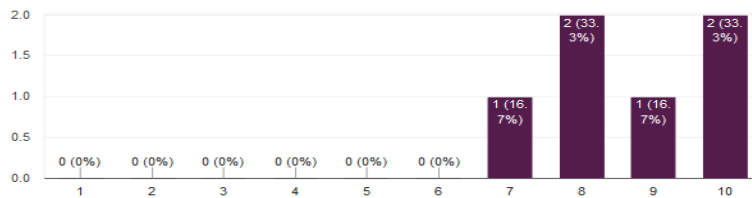


Evaluation of communication and cooperation

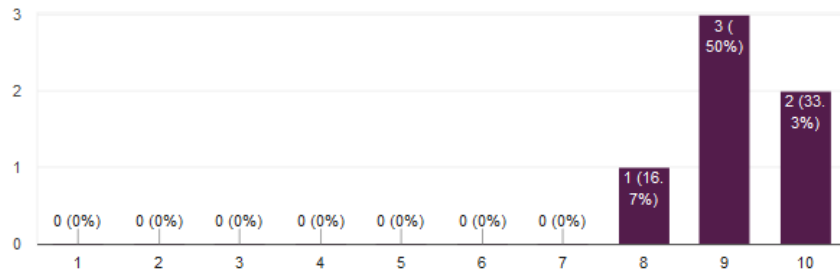

I works quite good, and it is usefull for us to read what the students are thinking about the projects's activities.

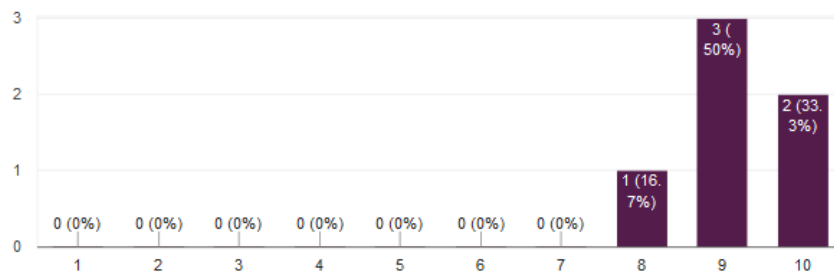
We were punctual and rich in content, the students love them.

The best distance activity. Even if there are some problems with technology (sound, image) it is really good to communicate with students from another school, say hello and read a poem!

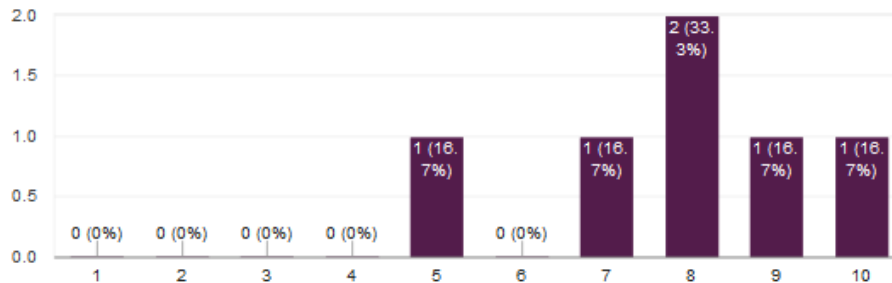
There were minor technical problems, but all is working well by now. They are probably the most exciting activity for our students, besides going to mobility.

Some students complained that their penpals didn't answer them. We should rethink the instructions.

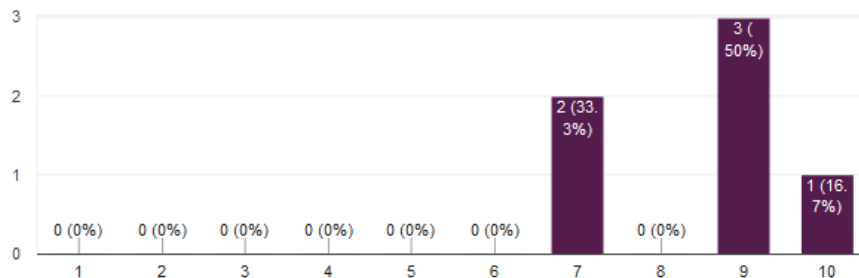
An interesting experience for the students that are involved in this activity.
