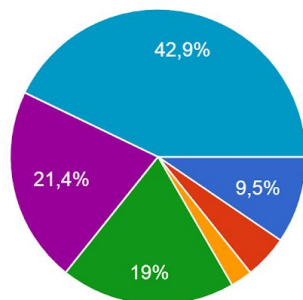

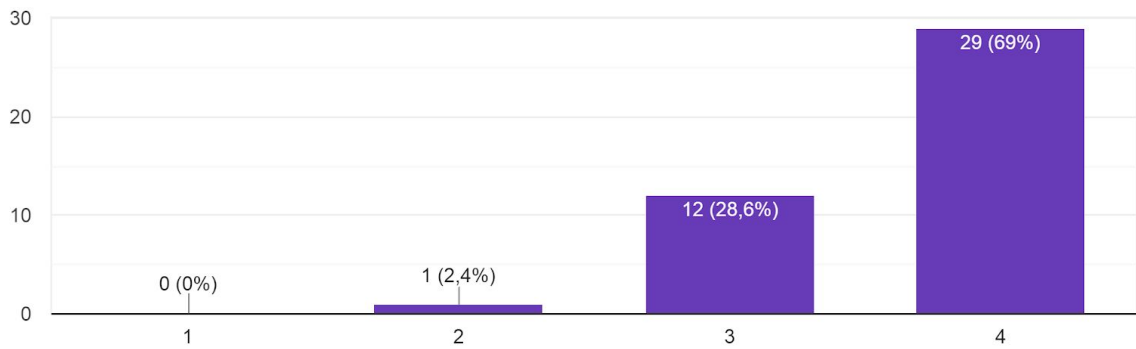
Which country are you from

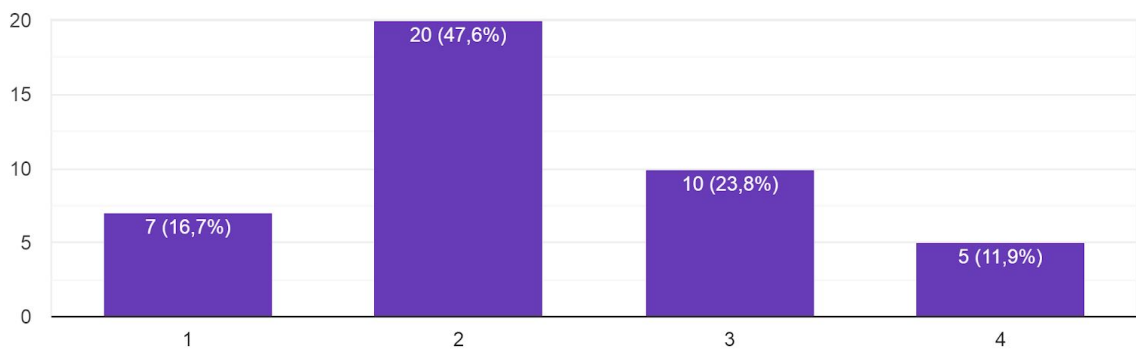
Do you think you practised English a lot during the meeting?

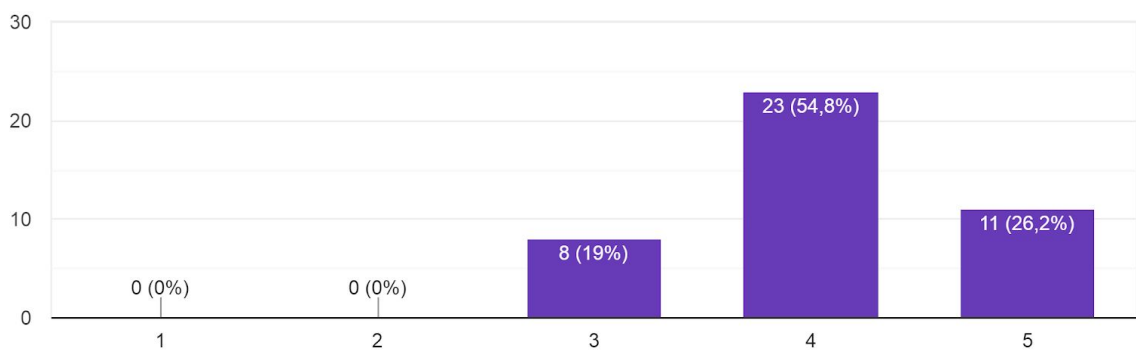
Did you use your TwinSpace?

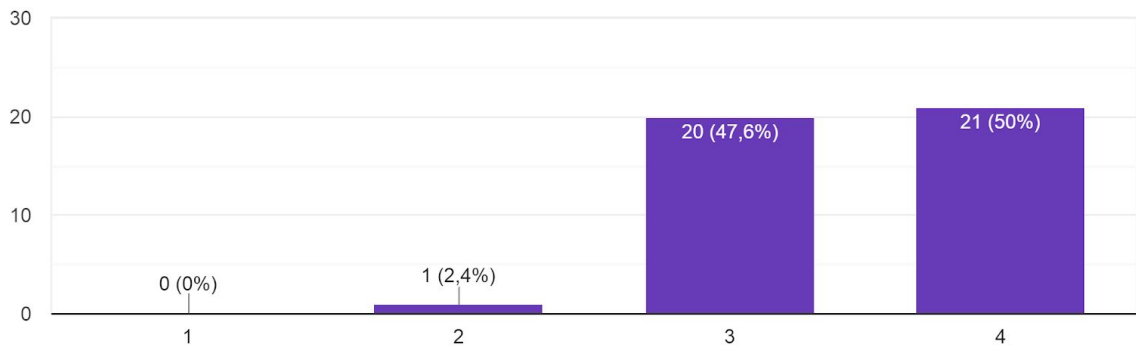
How was the meeting organized?

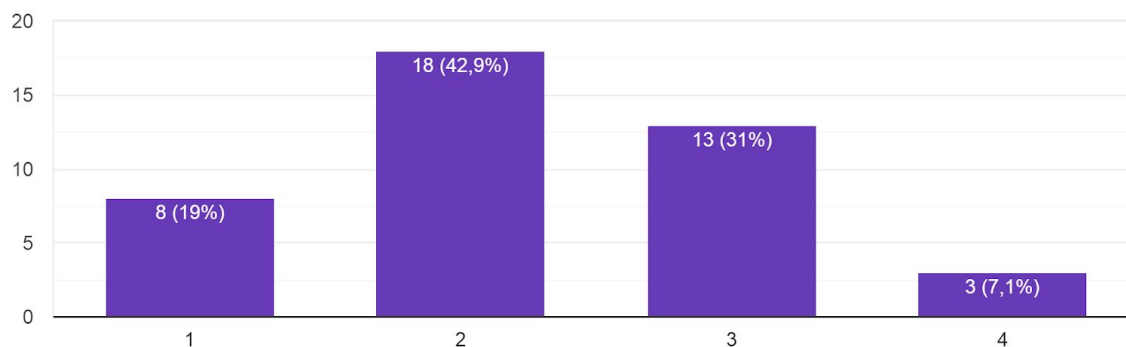

Yes because it was a really fascinating experience that i will remember for a lifetime i met people made memories and learned new things

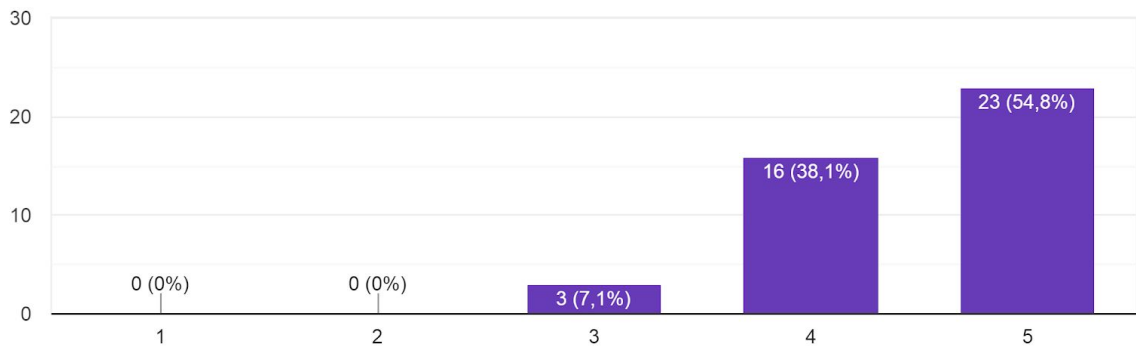

Yes, as it is something extraordinary!



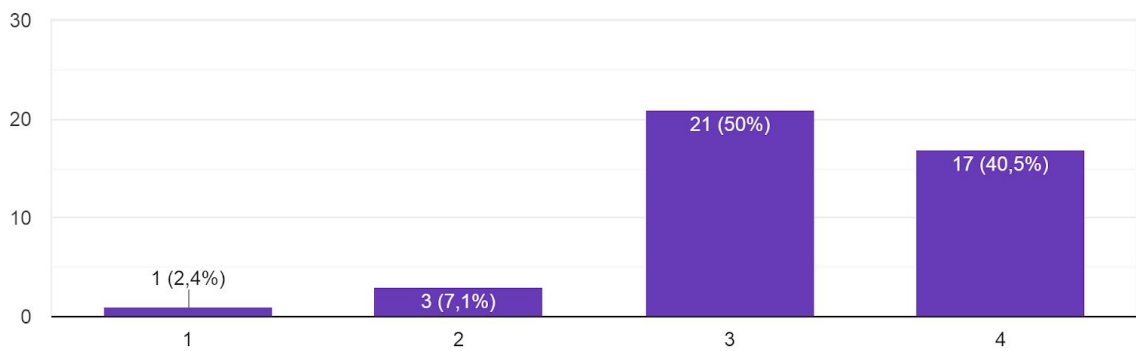
What is your overall impression of the meeting?

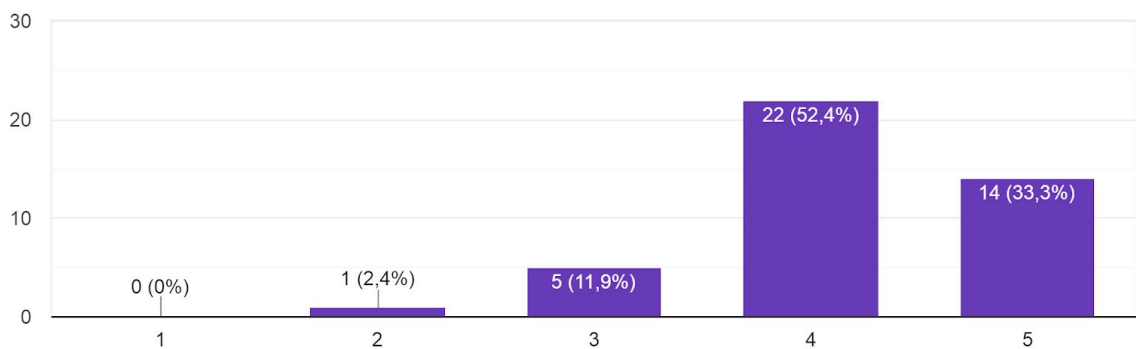
Do you think there was enough communication between the groups of different nationalities?

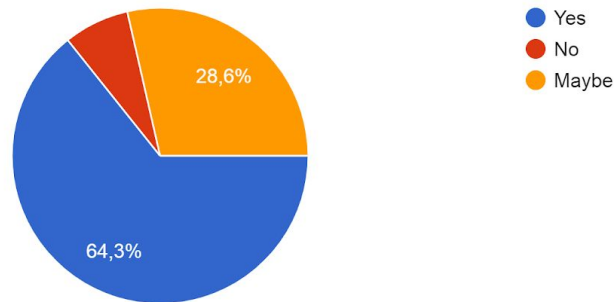
How did the programme meet your expectations?

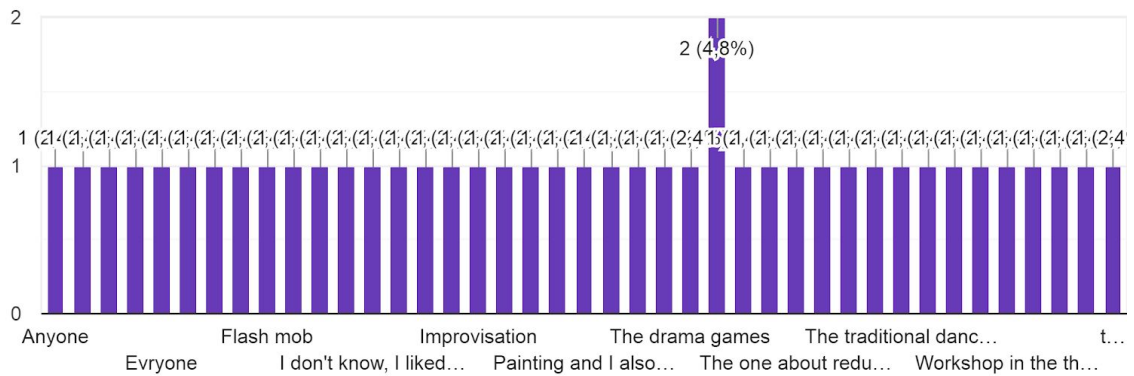
Was the timetable appropriate?

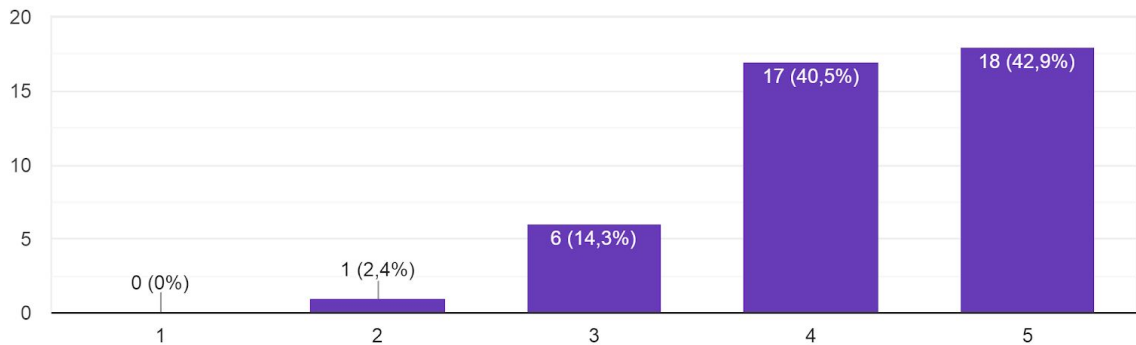
To give more time in the activities
