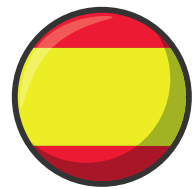


Spanish history of the 20th century.



1874

The Bourbon Monarchy was finally restored and Alfonso XII became king of Spain and its colonies.

He reigned using bipartidism. Conservatives and Liberals turned the government of Spain

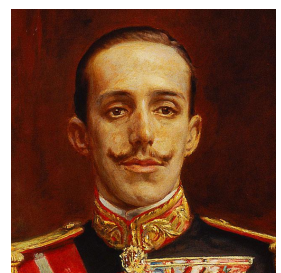


1886

Alfonso XIII became king at 17 years old when his father died at 26.

His reign was very conflictive due to the war in Morocco, the lost of the last colonies of Spain...

He abdicated in 1931 with the proclamation of the II Republic of Spain



1923

Some years before the II Republic Alfonso XIII created a dictatorship whose leader was Miguel Primo de Rivera.

He did a coup d'etat and the government abdicated.

He managed to stabilize



1931

The Second Spanish Republic was the democratic regime that existed in Spain between April 14, 1931 and April 1, 1939

With the second republic there was the civil war where the republic ended.



1936

In 1936 the Spanish Civil War began where the Republican side and the Falangist side fought.

In 1939 the civil war ended with the victory of the Falangist side and the end of the republic.



1939

A dictatorship is established by the Falangists and led by the leader Francisco Franco.



1975

In 1975 the Franco dictatorship ended by the death of the Caudillo.

Juan Carlos I replaced Franco and installed a constitutional monarchy in Spain.

Francisco inaugurated the San Bartolomé reservoir in 1942 improving the regadio system of Ejea.
