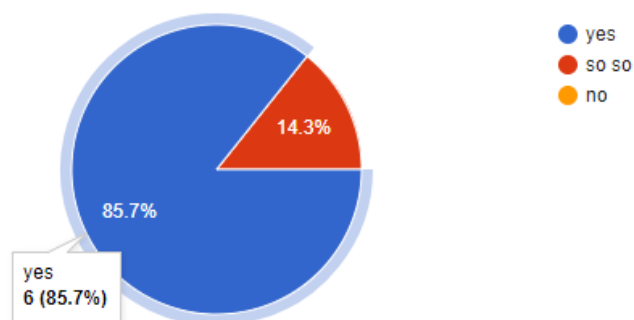

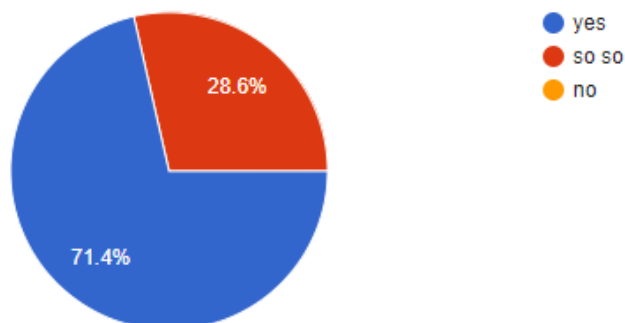
1. Did students from your school get to know pupils from the partner schools?

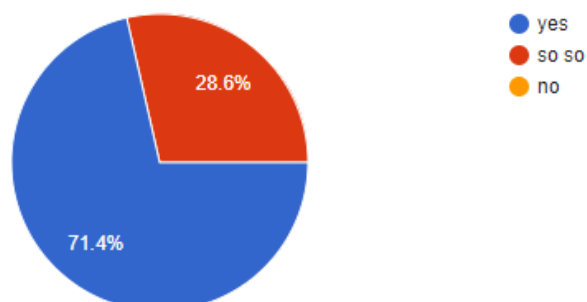
2. Did you enhance your knowledge of how CLIL techniques are used in Narva Kesklinna Gümnaasium?

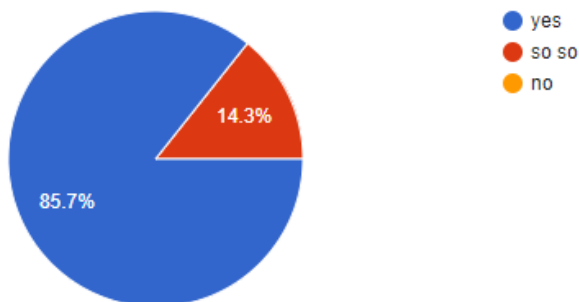

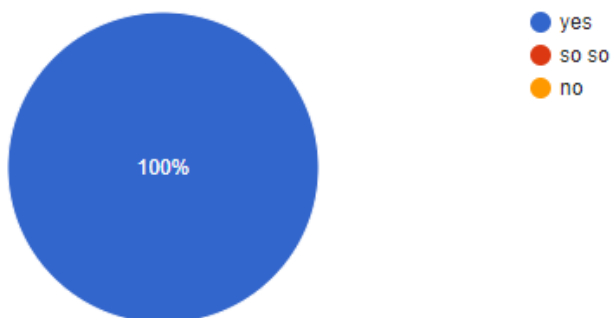

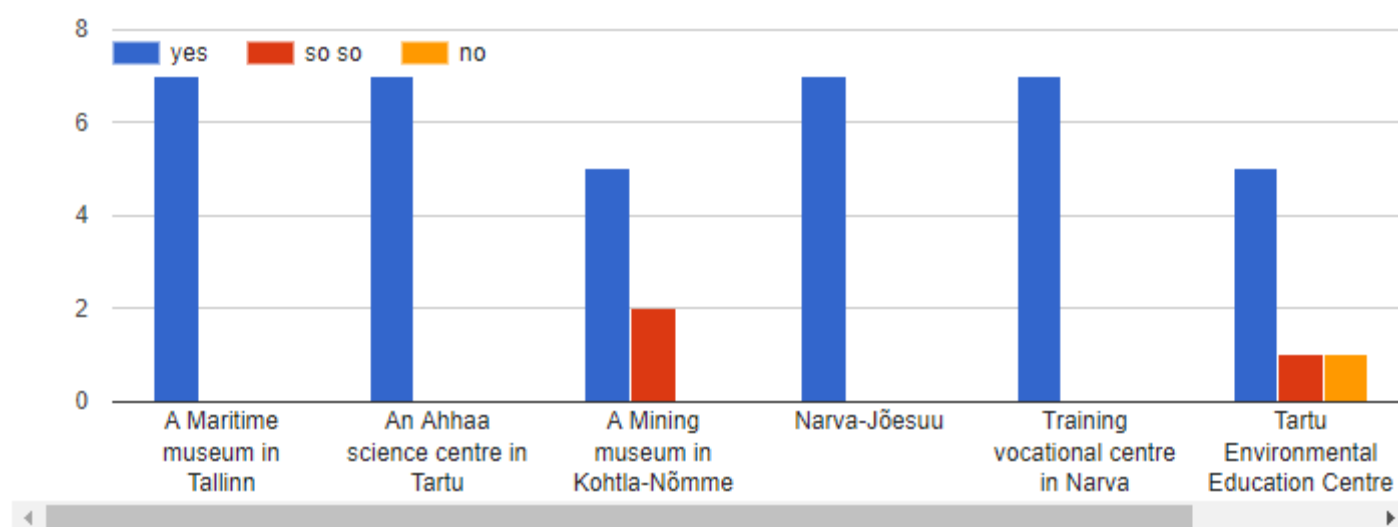

A country of contrasts. Beautiful cities. Different customs. Use of Estonian and Russian. History of the country.

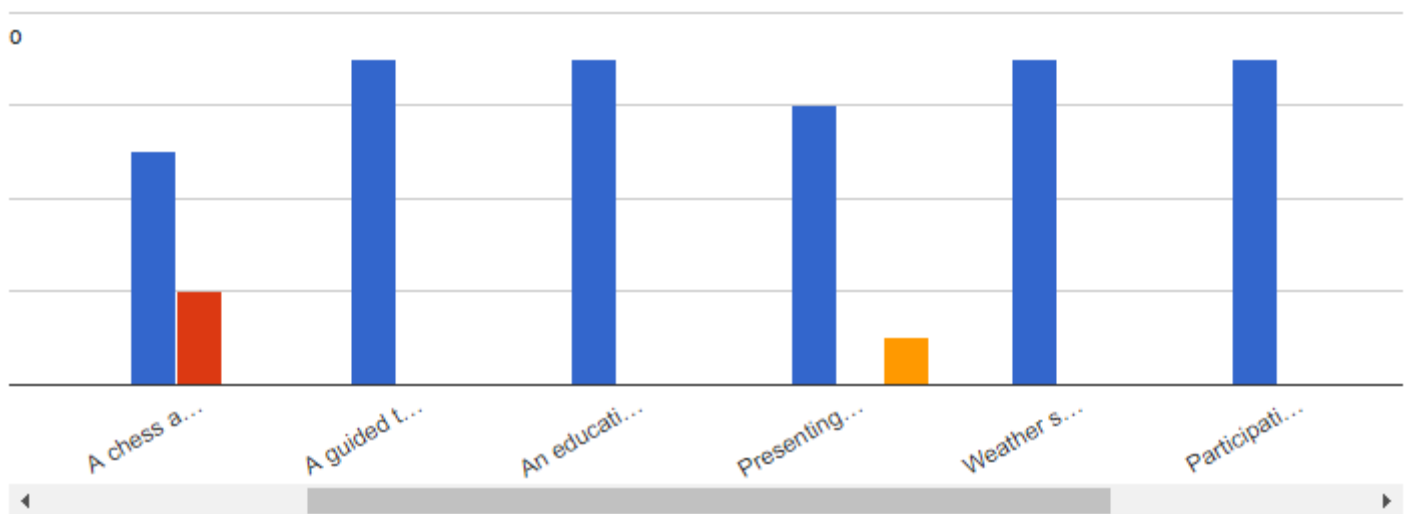
The contrast between my country and Estonia is huge, therefore I found it very interesting.

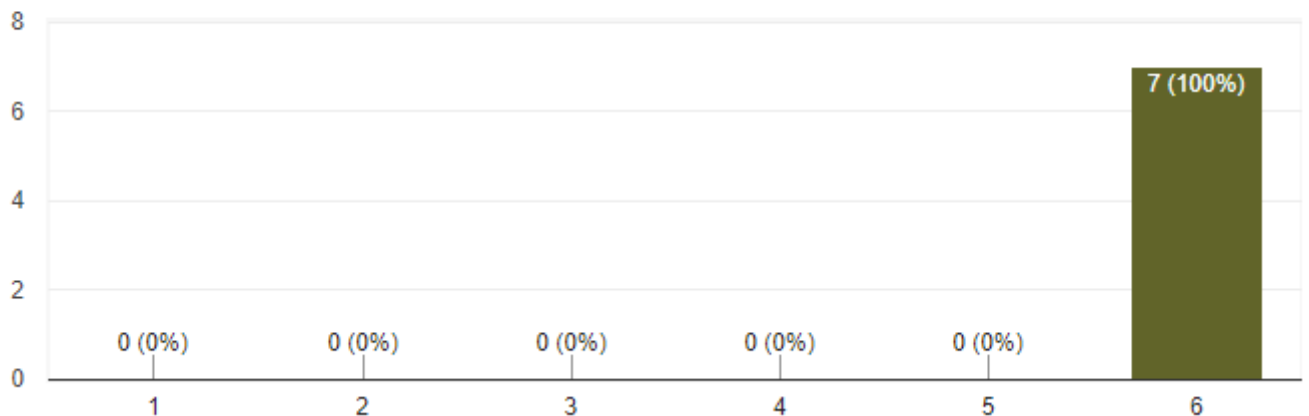

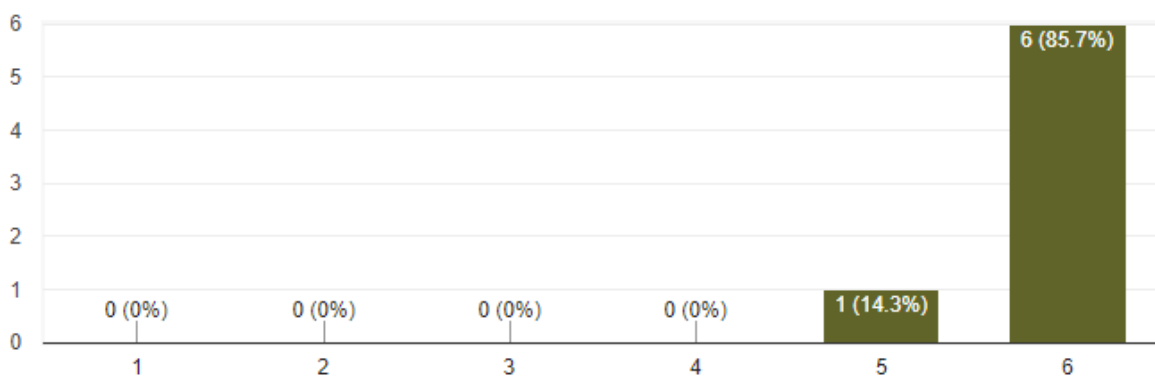
