#### The school is located in Estonia (Eesti), in the town of Narva.









The population of Narva is about 58 000 inhabitants.

Narva is the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest town in Estonia.

The school is one of the oldest educational institutions in the town, as it was founded in 1926.





There are about 1000 students (Russian native speakers) studying and 70 teachers working in the school at present.





# Our school has been successfully using the CLIL methodology since 2005 the

**Estonian-language-immersion** 

programme.





Starting from the primary school many subjects are taught in the Estonian language for our students. In the Upper-Secondary level the majority of subjects (60%) are taught in the national language.





Lessons start at 8 am and finish at about 2-3pm. The lessons last 45 minutes and there are 15-minute-breaks between the lessons.




In Pierre de Nolhac, there are 599 pupils. There are 35 teachers.

every 7 or 8 weeks; they last 2 weeks.


#### Sciences in our school

In France, we have to be good at maths to go to a good school, so maths are very important in our country.




#### Lunch at the canteen

# SPORTS












In PE classes, we will practice 5 sports this year:





A tramline connects Sintra and Praia das Maçãs.






#### Famous portuguese explorers ...
