We are learning about Glass in art, and glass in daily produkts.

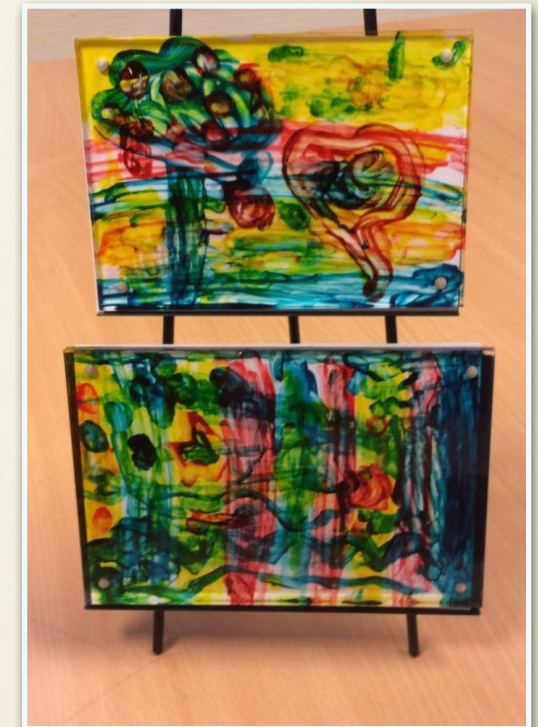
In Moss we had a big factory making glass products.

Old handcrafts in Moss.

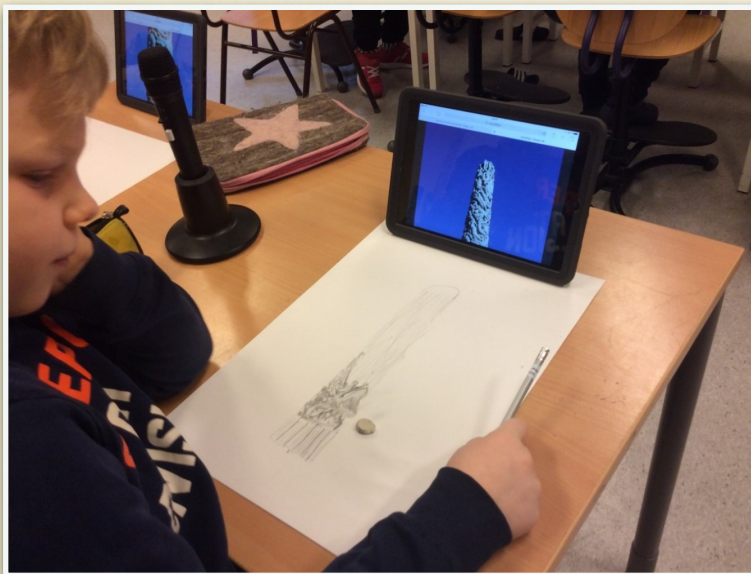
We have been working with paperproduction at an old factory in Moss called Peterson & son. We have made our own paper at the town museum. We have used this paper to make our own book about the history of the factory, and the craft of making paper from timber.

We have been working with the Norwegian sculpturer Gustav Vigeland. He has made many sculptures that are in a park in Oslo, Vigelandsparken. We have drawn on paper, painted, buildt with lego and clay. In June we are all going to Oslo and to Vigelandsparken to look at them ourselves.





## Arts and Crafts - Ramberg Skole

Our 4. grade students have worked with local industries from the old days. The name of the industry is Moss Glassverk, they were the biggest supplier of glass in Norway. We have also worked with our most famous artist Edvard Munch known for his painting "Scream".

Edvard Munch lived in Moss for a short period of his life from 1913-1916. While he lived in Moss he painted "Arbeidere på hjemvei" (workers on their way home). This painting was an inspiration for the work of our students who made art from different materials.

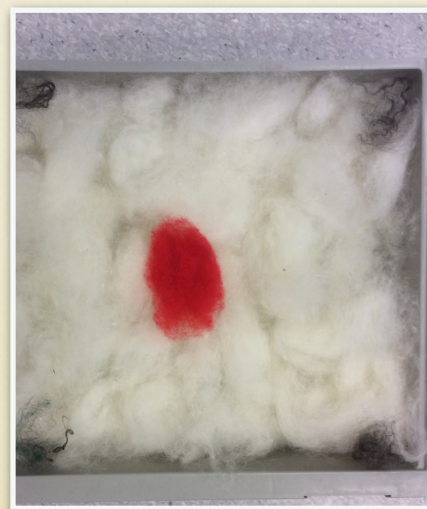
These different materials is paper from weeklies, yarn, paint and tissue paper. They have worked with these artwork in groups of 2-4 students.





### Arts and craft 5th grade

We have worked with wool as a material. We chose to work with this because this is an old traditional material they used in the old days to make different kind of clothes and other things. The children carded and felted the wool, they made a shoe sole each that we at the end of the project put together to a sheep as an artwork. The children also learned about the importance of the sheep in the old days and how the families utilised the wool themselves.

## Arts and crafts 6th grade

We have learned more about one of Norway's most famous artists Edvard Munch.

Munch was chosen because he lived on "our island" for three years. All the pupils wrote about his life and his paintings, and they made their own "Munch paintings". Some made presentations too.





7th grade worked with the work *Scream* by the Norwegian painter Edvard Munch (whom actually lived in Moss for some years in his carrier) for one week. Every day we learned a new aspect of the painting, the feelings expressed in the picture (anxiety), the artist or the period in which the *Scream* was painted. We had a session with theory almost every day, but had the main focus on practical learning. We did crayons on cardboard, tempera on canvas and cardboard – but also wanted to do the motive in a new perspective. For our new innovations we did the *Scream* in environmental friendly projects such as magazine mosaic, expressed the painting through Edvard Grieg's musical play (*Dovregubben's hall*) and a picture made of milkcorks. Our most ambitious project was two big wall paintings and two garphitti outdoor variants of the *Scream*.
