





1. To what extent do you appreciate the usefulness of the knowledge acquired and the skills formed within the project?




2. To what extent have you improved your language skills as a result of participating in this project?




3. To what extent have you improved your digital skills as a result of participating in this project?




4. How exactly did the fact that you were part of the target group of the project change you? (Several answers can be chosen)




5. To what extent did participating in the project enrich your knowledge about local culture and traditions?
