General aspects to highlight in the participant related to objectives written in the Mobility agreement.

Ms Carmen Belen Munoz Carmona visited math and computer scienc classes in our school this week from Monday 4th to Friday 8th April 2022.

- She speaks a fluent French and was in the capacity of sharing impressions and ideas thouroughly with the French teachers.
- She also visited some math in English classes.
- She visited 18 hours of classes in the week, which is also the usual teaching duration for a French teacher.
- She attended some Engineering project classes to obtain a complete overview of STEM classes led as a project based pedagogy.
- She followed some non teaching staff as student referent to obtain a global overview of the atmosphere between students and adults in the school.
- She shared a presentation of her own professional practices with some other math teachers from the region Normandy.

- She could attend both “traditional pedagogy” classes and “innovative pedagogy” classes, depending on the project based pedagogy or not. Her critical thinking on the practices she could see played the role of a mirror for some teachers during the fruitful conversations.

Other aspects to highlight in the participant

- She is the first foreign teacher to visit our school in an Erasmus jobshadowing mobility. She obviously played the role of an Erasmus ambassador for teachers and staff without groups of students.
- Her experience in our school clearly initiated some ideas and wishes by the French teachers to apply for a jobshadowing mobility in another school abroad.
- Her openminded mindset and her complete language skills led to share deeply with several French teachers, about differences and similarities between the French and the Spanish education systems.
