In my village, Aspra, today Carnival is not celebrated very much. Only children celebrate it.

They wear costumes, attend parades and have fun with confetti and streamers.

The costumes are inspired by well-known characters at that time. Younger children are dressed in kitten or puppy and go to the Oratory of the church that is festooned with garlands and balloons. Every night (from Friday before Carnival to the Shrove Tuesday) you can dance and shout and receive confectionery and prizes.
