holiday



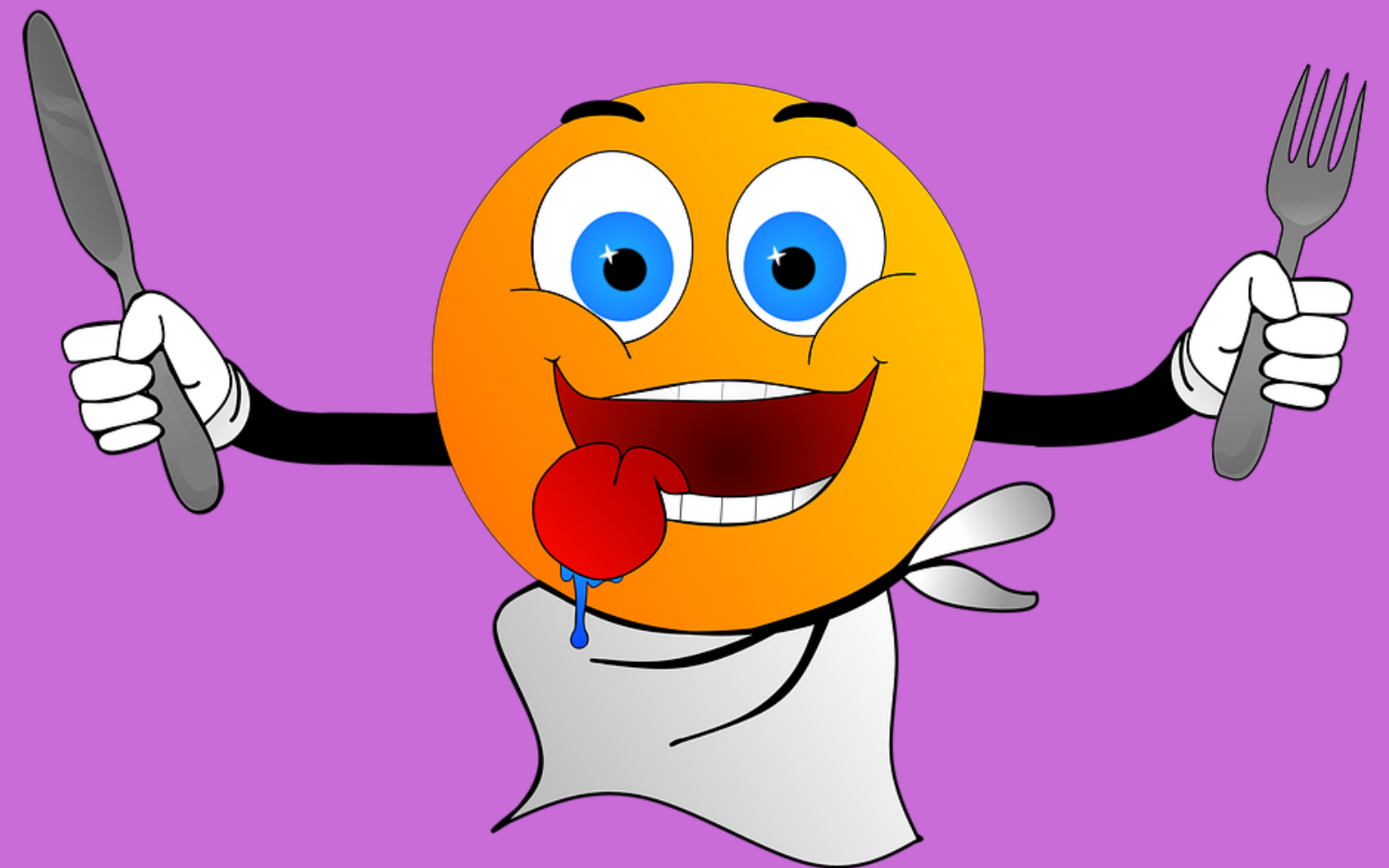
And it was very
