Finally, the participated in a Music Workshop creating and playing instruments. At the end they all performed a song together as they were an orchestra.

This day we continued with the singing contest so that all teams could perform all the songs they had prepared. At the end of this session one student from each team was the winner, getting a nice gift for the good effort showed in the activity.

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After a break students started to devise the joint products in mixed groups.

All the Erasmus students worked hard on the final product of the project unifying all the information the different countries prepared in their PowerPoints and drawing their own conclusions about the research.

This day we could finish school earlier and students had lunch with their host families and had some leisure activities with the families in the afternoon.

FOURTH DAY – THURSDAY 20th

The fourth day was a tiring one, but full with emotions and new knowledge as we spent they day at Porto. All 5 countries' teams visited first visited the "Casa da música", where they enjoyed a very interesting tour about the history and characteristics of this special place.
