

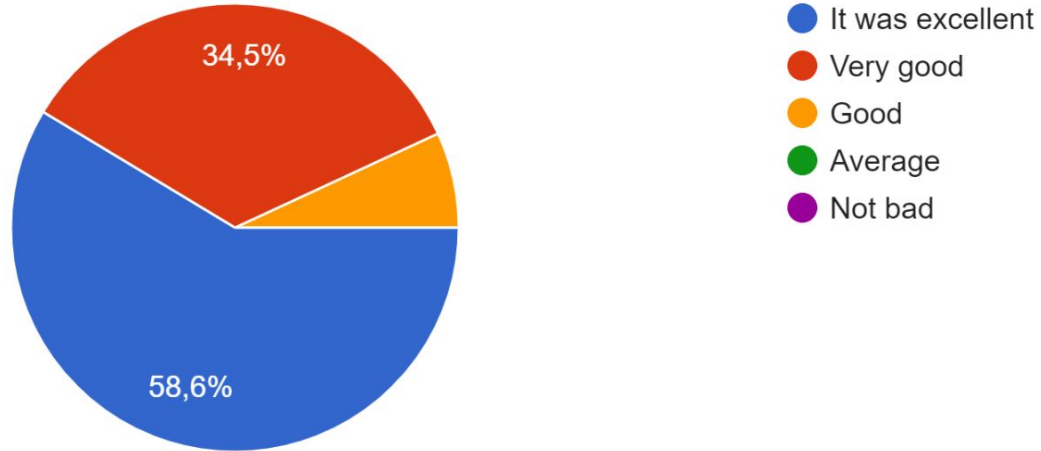

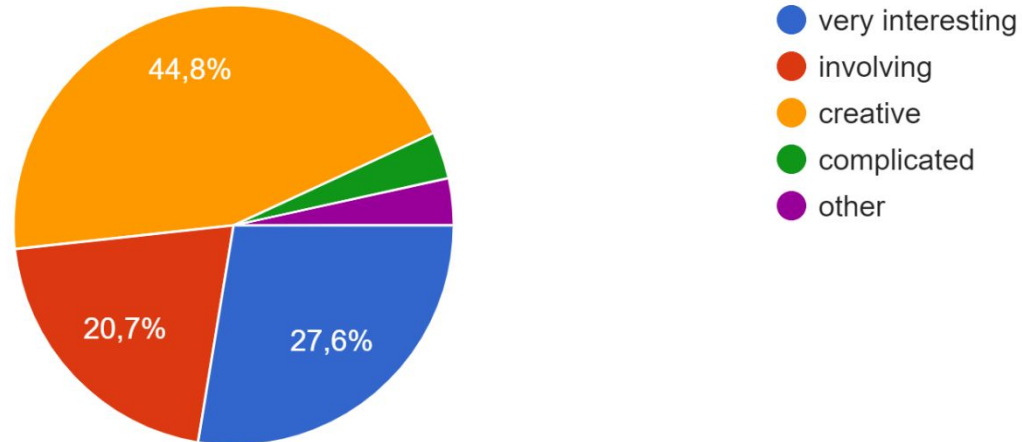
1. How would you evaluate the program of the mobility in general?

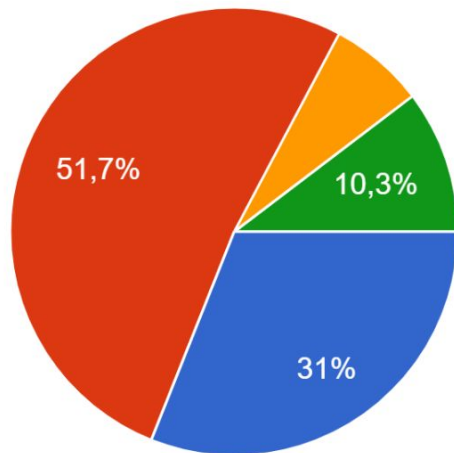
2. What is your evaluation of the project activities/workshops? They were...

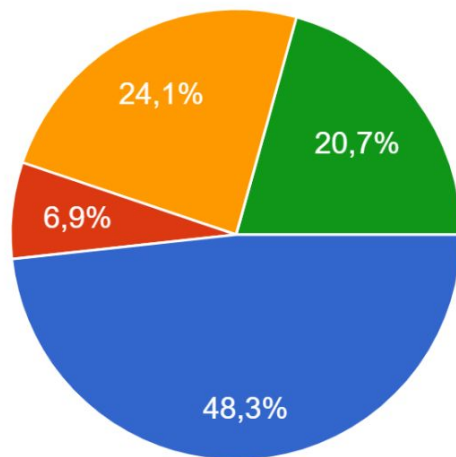

4. What was the food like at school?

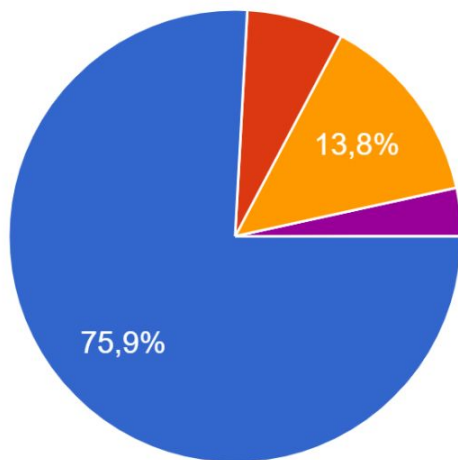
