


Hotel: Room (10 responses)

Hotel: Breakfast (10 responses)





Hotel: Customer Service (9 responses)




a bit expensive









More funny than scary...





Trip: National Museum of Scotland (10 responses)





Activity: Our Futuristic School (Wednesday) (10 responses)





Activity: Edcuational Game Board (Wednesday & Friday) (10 responses)









Scottish Evening: Ceilidh (Scottish Dancing) (10 responses)


