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**The Evaluation of the 3rd LTT Activities that were held at Colegiul
Național ,Ion Luca Caragiale' from Moreni, Romania**

There were 41 participants who answered this questionnaire. Their answers are as follows:

1.What have you learnt during this meeting about all partner countries?

The participants have answered that they have learnt that all the partners are committed to doing the project's activities. They have all been interested in protecting the environment, in learning how the environment was affected by consumption so that they could find ways to reduce the environmental issues. They have also been all active participants in the mock job fair where they have been eager to learn as much as possible. They have said that they have learnt that we are all the same, with similar problems and expectations.

2. Do you think that the five teams prepared the work for the meeting well?

The participants have said that they consider the five teams prepared the work for the meeting well.

3. Do you think that the participants made some progress or achieved some results?

The participants have answered that they have made much progress regarding the acquisition and improvement of skills that the project's objectives targeted at and together they have created the final products.

4. What exactly did you learn during this project meeting?

They have said that they have learnt about the environmental issues that the five countries confront with, they have learnt ways to diminish these problems, that even within their families they can help to decrease energy consumption. They have learnt how consumption affects the environment, what the job trends in each partner country are. They have mentioned that they have learnt the necessary steps to apply for a job, how to write a letter of intent, a CV, what the employers are looking for at a job interview and the tips for how to behave at an interview. They have learnt about the Romanian education system, the Romanian way of life and how to work in an international team.

5. How was the general working atmosphere during the meeting?

The participants have said that the general working atmosphere during the meeting was great, pleasant, excellent. It was an atmosphere of cooperation, tolerance and mutual respect.

6. Was the meeting successful? In which way?

The participants have said that the meeting was successful as they created the final products, they acquired and developed the skills and competences targeted at the project's objectives, they have met their partners.

7. Were you satisfied with the accommodation and facilities? (E.g location, rooms, food, seminar room, equipment ?)

The participants have said that the Romanian team organized everything well.

8. Do you think that the project will make positive or negative development? [E.g risks, threats, problems as well as chances opportunities]

The participants have considered that the project will make a positive development as the participants have acquired skills and competences that will be beneficial in the future and they have stated that there are no threats as they are fully committed to achieving the project's objectives.
