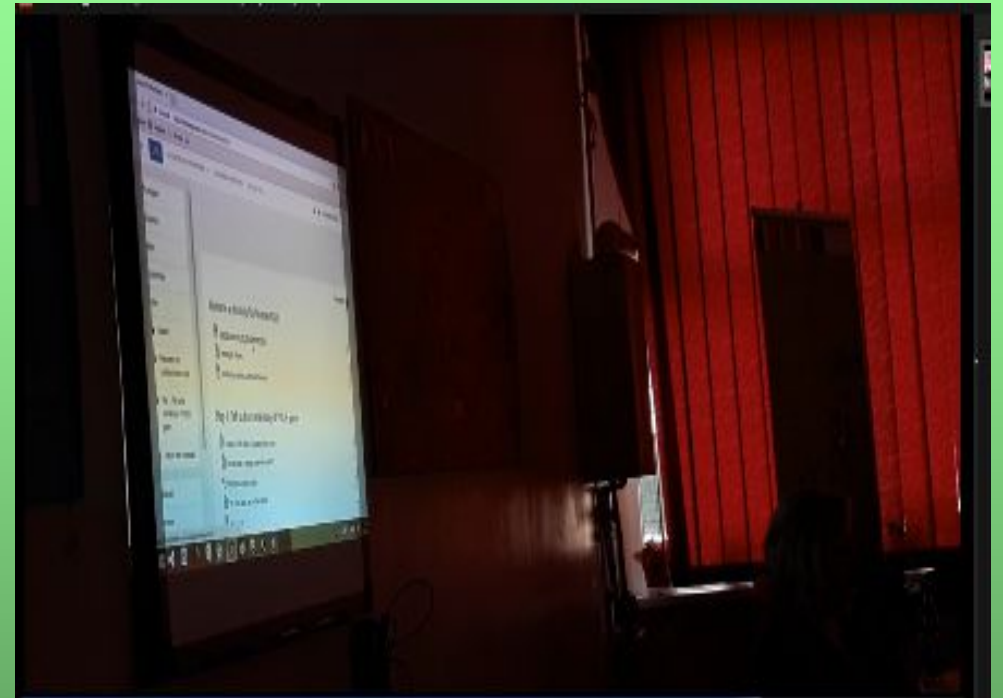
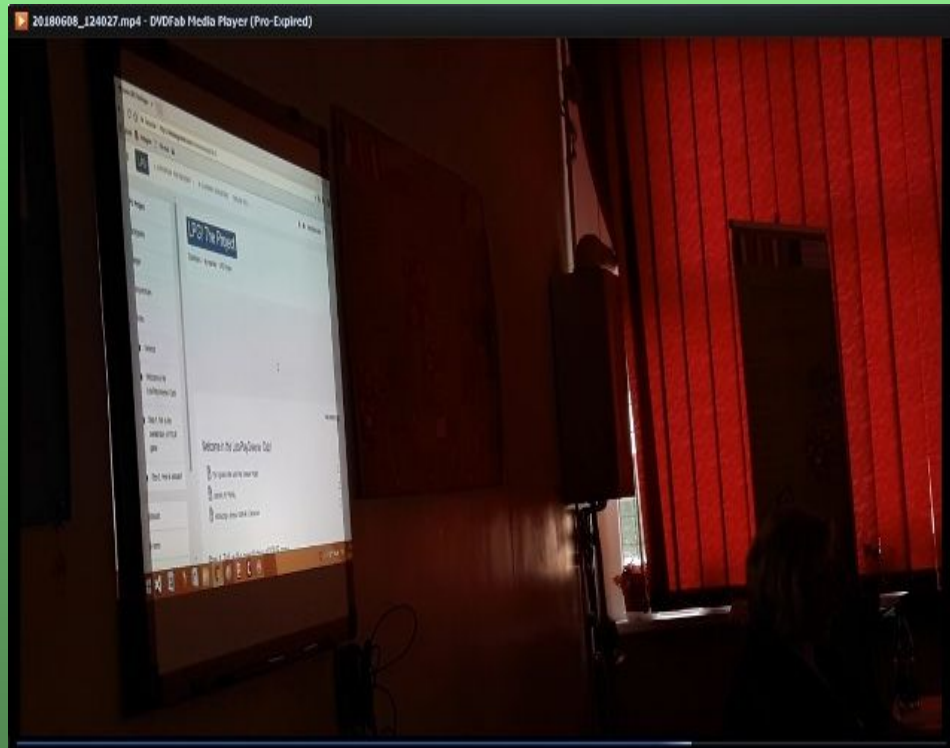
### **Dissemination Workshop held at Colegiul National 'Ion Luca Caragiale' from Moreni.**

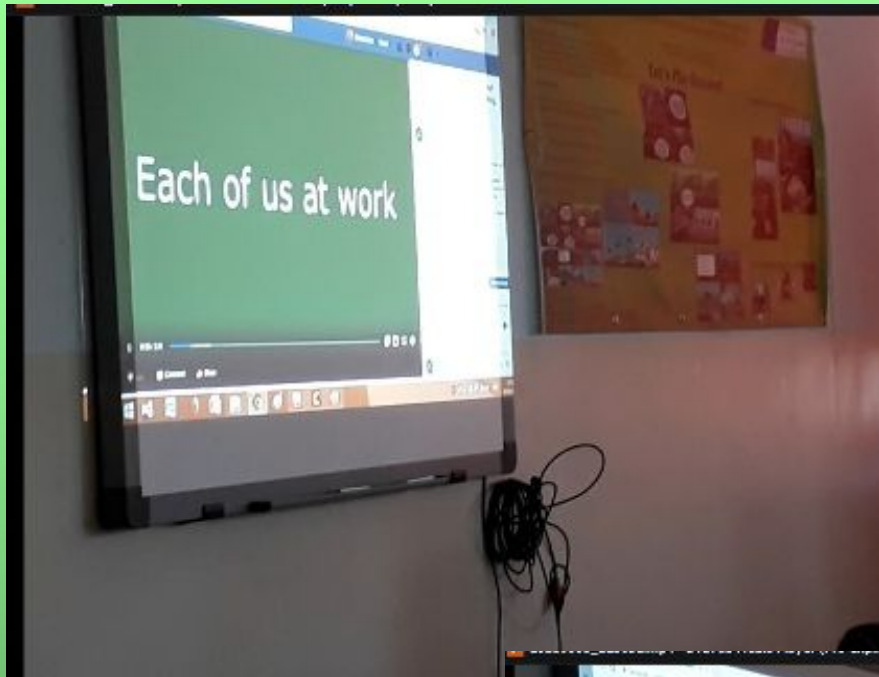


The second learning, teaching and training activities that took place in Moreni.
