**Evaluation of the second Learning/Teaching/Training Activities, held in Colegiul National „Ion Luca Caragiale”, in Moreni, Romania, between 21.05.2018-25.05.2018**

The evaluation questionnaire was applied on the last day of the project meeting to 51 participants in the second Learning/Teaching/Training Activities. The aim of this evaluation was to assess the key aspects of the meeting in terms of results, achievement of objectives, organisation, skills acquired, organisation and the future development of the project.

This material presents the questions that were asked, some of the respondents' answers and the interpretation of replies.

**1. What are the key aspects that you have learnt during this meeting about all partners countries?**

The participants have mentioned that they have learnt about the host country's customs, food, way of life, people's generosity and friendliness, and also about educational systems. They have had the chance to compare the ways life, school life and classes are in the three countries. They have written about the fact that they have seen how their partners work, communicate, socialise, and that together, in teams, as they call this 'spirit team,' they can achieve great results. They have said that they are all the same, they can be good friends even though they do not speak the same language or they do not have the same religion. They also mentioned that they have learnt to use the programmes to design the game.

Some of the participants' answers:

- 'I have learnt that we have the same spirit, we want to cooperate to make something important and to know one another, the fact that people are friendly, hospitable, reliable and aim to progress'.

-- 'The key aspect that I have learnt during this meeting about all partner countries is that we are all the same, we can learn from each other and we can be friends above all the religion differences.'

- ‘I learnt that even though we don’t know each other, we can communicate and make a good team.’
- ‘I learnt that we are people with common interests’.
- ‘I learnt that we are all the same, we don’t need to speak the same language for being friendly.’
- ‘I learnt to draw with Krita and to work with a lot of people in teams. I think that this is very pleasant.’
- ‘ They are so sweet people.’
- ‘They are all funny, generous and really kind with us.’
- ‘The Romanians are generous and funny.’
- ‘ People’s kindness and the customs of Romania’
- ‘They are very generous and friendly.’
- ‘I have learnt what collective work is. It’s very good.’
- ‘Working together and mutual aid.’
- ‘We learnt a lot of things about culture, knowledge and educational systems.’
- ‘ I improved my graphic skills.’
- ‘I learnt that if we are working together we can make great things’
- ‘high level in English helps a lot’
- ‘I learnt to communicate more with others’
- ‘How to code better and how to work in a team’
- ‘Spirit team, food, English language and game design’
- ‘Food, Krita, English, Romanian’
- ‘Graphic skills, spirit team, improving my skills in English’
- ‘Managing an international team of students’
- ‘Spirit team, food, Krita, fellow liking’

- ‘ I learnt about the culture and how to programme the game’
- ‘I learnt the way the other countries work’
- ‘ They are all so friendly and I worked very well with them’
- ‘How to communicate with other people and enjoy their company’
- ‘ How to design levels and how to implement them in Stencyl, how to communicate with people from other countries.’
- ‘I have learnt that teamwork and communication are very important in a project.’
- ‘Socialising and communicating with other people with different opinions from different countries.’
- ‘The key aspects that I’ve learnt are how to communicate and how to use the drawing programme.’
- ‘I’ve learnt that for a well-done job, you need all the help.’
- ‘I have learnt how to properly speak English, how to use Stencyl and Krita.’
- ‘I have learnt a lot about each country’s culture and way of life’
- ‘Socialising with foreign people’
- ‘I have learnt some words in Romanian.’

**2. Were you satisfied with the accommodation and facilities? (E.g. location, rooms, service, food, seminar room, equipment, internet connection)?**

Most participants said that they had been satisfied with everything, but 4 of them mentioned that sometimes, at school, the internet connection had not worked properly and one respondent said ‘some of it yes, some no’

Some of the participants’ answers:

- ‘ I was very satisfied. The girl where I live was lovely with me and her family, too. My room is very good. The food in Romania is very good and I have the Internet connection. I enjoy this project in Romania.’
- ‘I will talk about Romania a lot when I am back home.’

- The family who hosted me always wanted me to feel good and comfortable’
- ‘ I was satisfied, but as usual, the Internet connection has to be improved.’
- ‘Good location and food.’/ ‘ amazing food and charming town’
- We are all grateful for all the organisation of this event’
- ‘I love the location, it was very typical. Food was very good.’
- ‘It was amazing’ ./ ‘It was good’/ ‘ It was all perfect, I was really satisfied.’/ Everything was great’
- ‘ Yes, I was satisfied with the accommodation. The conditions were more than we needed.’
- ‘Everything was more than fine’

### **3. Do you think that the three teams prepared the work for the meeting well?**

All the respondents have said that the teams prepared well for the meeting and we did a great job.

Some of the answers:

- ‘ I think that the three teams prepared everything according to the agenda that had been established beforehand. ‘
- ‘ Yes,I think that the 3 teams are complex and we did a good job’
- ‘ Yes, I think that the three teams prepared the work for the meeting well.’
- ‘ Yes, we worked very well’/ Yes, we worked well all together.’
- ‘ Yes, I really think that everybody did their job very well.’
- ‘ I think yes, we work hard’/ Yes, I really do.’/ ‘ very well’
- Yes, I think it was well done.’/ Everyone did their best.’
- ‘ Yes they prepared the work part for the meeting very well’
- ‘ I saw that the three teams were serious about the fact of producing good things for the project’

### **4 How was the general working atmosphere during the meeting? (E.g. Did all partners contribute to the project meeting? Was everybody’s opinion accounted for and respected?)**

All respondents said that the working atmosphere had been great, everybody's opinion had counted, they all had worked as a team and all partners had contributed to the project activities during the meeting.

Some of the respondents' answers:

- 'The general working atmosphere was one of friendship'
- 'The atmosphere was fantastic'
- 'Everyone contributed to the project in a respectful and pleasant way'
- 'All opinions were respected and the ideas of all people were heard'
- 'The teams were working and it was a great atmosphere'
- 'There was a good atmosphere. I think everyone contributed and each opinion was respected'
- 'The general atmosphere was very friendly and we all contributed to the project meeting and shared our opinions.'
- 'Everything was good and everybody was kind'
- 'Everybody contributed and we socialized with each other'
- 'Really great and happy.'
- 'The general atmosphere was awesome and friendly'
- 'We shared our opinions freely'
- 'A great atmosphere thanks to everybody 'cause they were really interested in others'
- 'Everyone did something useful.'
- 'There was a unique and great atmosphere during the meeting; we got along very well.'
- 'Everybody was really trying to do their best'
- 'Pleasant, we all worked as a team'
- 'It was pleasant, everybody was communicative and open to new ideas'

- ‘We all talked and communicated with each other and we were a big team’
- ‘We all worked together, we communicated and had fun.’
- ‘All partners contributed to the project and the general working atmosphere was super cool and funny.’
- ‘We all worked together in a pleasant atmosphere.’
- ‘I really liked the atmosphere, enjoying every minute of this.’
- ‘The teachers took into account every opinion’.
- ‘It was a friendly atmosphere. The people were friendly and nice.’
- ‘We all worked together and we had fun.’
- ‘I think it was awesome. We all worked as a team to create something wonderful.’
- ‘The atmosphere was one of cooperation and mutual respect. Everybody’s opinion was respected and all partners contributed to the unfolding of the activities.’

### **5. What is your opinion on the way the meeting was managed?**

The respondents considered that the meeting had been managed well, all the tasks had been done, the teachers had explained everything and the students understood what they had to do. There was an answer in which the respondent did not express any opinion for this question.

Some of the participants’ answers:

- ‘It was well- organised.’
- Well- organised and the message was received’
- It was well- organised. I learnt much information about Romanian culture and ecology.’
- ‘Yes, well- managed.’/’The meeting was organised well.’
- The organisation was not fantastic, but not bad.’
- ‘I spent good moments and the management was good’
- ‘I think it was good’
- ‘When there have been problems, they have been solved on the spot’
- ‘The meeting was managed pretty well and hopefully we will achieve what we wanted’
- It is always difficult to manage so many people, but when there were problems , they were solved at the best’

- ‘The meeting was fairly managed just considering the fact that I wasn’t complaining about anything.’
- ‘I was impressed.’/ ‘Good meeting’/ ‘Good organisation.’
- ‘No opinion’/ ‘ We had wonderful hosts.’
- ‘ It could have been better but it was great.’/ ‘Good managing.’
- ‘ The teachers helped us with everything that we needed.’
- ‘We had a fixed program and we respected it, so the meeting was great.’
- ‘The meeting was organised in a nice way.’
- ‘The meeting was managed perfectly’
- ‘It was managed well and organised nicely.’
- ‘I think that the teachers managed the meeting very well, they helped us with everything that we wanted and the work was done at the perfect time.’
- ‘No problems existed.’
- ‘It was managed well and I understood everything I had to do.’
- ‘Well managed, we could fulfil our tasks.’
- ‘The meeting was well –organised and if/ when it had happened that a problem appeared, it was solved immediately.’

## **6. Was the meeting successful? In which way?**

The participants considered that the meeting was successful because the project objectives had been reached, they worked and communicated well with their peers, they could express their opinions which were taken into account, they met new people who are friendly with whom they made friends.

- ‘It was. The meeting showed us the fun in working in a team.’
- ‘Yes, because we have learnt new things and had a good time.’
- ‘Yes, because we worked very hard.’
- Yes, because I met a lot of teenagers.’/‘Obviously’
- ‘We advanced a lot in the game, so it was successful.’
- ‘All the goals have been achieved.’
- ‘Yes, because everybody was nice.’
- ‘It was successful because we reached our objectives.’
- ‘Yes, it was, all the goals have been achieved.’

- ‘Yes, it was. The collaboration and communication between the three teams were better day by day.’
- ‘ In every way it was successful.’
- ‘Yes, because we met amazing people.’
- ‘’ Even if we have yet a lot of stuff to achieve, this meeting goals are fully achieved.’
- ‘ Yes, we did all that we needed to do.’
- ‘ I think the meeting was successful because we did a great game.’
- ‘ It was a success in all the ways I could think.’
- ‘The meeting was successful, we accomplished all our missions.’
- ‘The meeting was certainly successful because we created a beautiful game.’
- ‘ We were able to do everything that we wanted and the work was done at the perfect time.’
- ‘ It was successful because everybody had fun’.
- ‘Yes, we learnt how to work together and got to know each other.’
- ‘’Yes, because Romanian people are very cool.’
- ‘Yes, because I met a lot of new people.’
- ‘ It was successful because we put together all the opinions.’
- ‘ Yes, it was. We succeeded in doing what we wanted, and this was the objective, after all.’
- ‘It was successful because we accomplished our goal.’
- ‘Yes, the participants cooperated in mixed teams, the organisation was good, we reached our objectives, we learnt about our partners’ culture and we made friends.’

**7. Do you think that the participants made some progress or achieved some results? What were these? . What exactly did you learn during this project meeting?**



The respondents considered that all the participants improved their digital skills, their level of English and their communicative and interpersonal skills. They learnt the steps for designing the game and about their partners 'culture and civilisation.

- 'I think that we all learnt new things during this week. Everybody did something and we managed very well.'
- 'Yes, everybody improved their skills.'
- 'Personally, I improved my informatics skills and my English.'
- 'Yes, I think that the participants have learnt how to work in a team and I learnt how to use Stencil better.'
- 'We learnt a lot of new things and how to work well in a group.'
- 'Yes, I think that it was a very good experience. I learnt to use a new informatics programme called Krita.'
- 'The participants made a lot of progress and I learnt how to use the programs of the PC.'
- 'Yes, I think the participants made some progress. I learnt the game design.'
- 'We worked fast and made progress on the construction of the game.'
- 'Yes, they did from different points of view: language, technologies, relationships...'
- 'I don't know, maybe. I learnt especially how to use Krita.'
- 'I learnt how to use Stencil. I saw the participant improving a lot.'
- 'I learnt graphics and how to use Krita.'
- 'Yes, graphics, coding.'
- 'Yes, improved my skills in graphics.'
- 'The result of the meeting is without comparison with the 'Paris' meeting. Students improved on software and in the overall intelligence of the project.'
- 'Yes, there have been results. I learnt the spirit team.'
- 'Yes, in game making. I learnt to program in Stencil.'
- 'We learnt about programming and how to work in Krita.'
- 'I believe that everyone made some progress and during this game I've learnt how to create songs fit for a game.'
- 'Everyone learnt to use Krita, Stencil, Audacity and we managed to do a cool game.'
- 'They certainly made progress and the results were the wanted ones.'
- 'I think we all made progress and achieved astonishing results. I personally learnt a lot about game design and mechanics.'
- 'I learnt how to work better on Krita and in a team.'
- 'I think that we all learnt how to work together.'
- 'Yes, they did. We managed to create the basis for a game.'
- 'I guess all participants made progress in game making and they learnt step by step how to make a game.'

- ‘We learnt to work as a team, to use the specific programs and to have a great time.’
- ‘The participants made a lot of progress and I learnt how to use informatics programs.’
- ‘Yes, we made new friends and we learnt how to work in a team with different programs.’
- Yes, I do. They improved their digital skills, they learnt how to use Krita, Stencyl and Audacity. They improved their English and raised their cultural awareness.’

## **8. What do you think of the partners’ contributions to the project?**

The respondents replied that all partners had contributed equally to the project and everybody did a great job.

- ‘We were all like a family and managed to work very well in order to create parts of the game.’
- ‘Everyone had a contribution.’
- ‘Everybody contributed equally.’
- ‘They contributed as much as we did.’
- ‘Our partners were very helpful, they always tried to help us when we needed.’
- ‘Yes, they contributed and it was of great help.’
- ‘Everyone had their part, we all contributed to the making of the game.’
- ‘All of them contributed and we managed to do everything in time.’
- ‘The partners’ contribution was equilibrated.’
- ‘All partners gave their contribution to the project.’
- ‘They worked very hard.’
- ‘They participated a lot.’
- ‘The main contributes deal with the improvement of linguistics and technological skills.’
- ‘They were really nice and intelligent.’
- ‘All of my partners contributed well to the project.’
- ‘Good’/ ‘It was a teamwork project.’/ ‘Good experience.’/ ‘Perfect.’
- ‘They did an amazing job.’
- ‘The share of responsibilities was ok, and also the collective work.’
- ‘I think it was good.’/ ‘It was perfect.’

## **9. If you think of the next steps of the project, do you believe that the project will make positive or negative development? (E.g. risks, threats, problems as well as chances, opportunities)**

All the participants considered that the project will make a positive development.

Some of the respondents' answers:

- 'I think that the project will make a positive impact.'
- 'I think it will develop in a positive way'/' Definitely, positive development.'
- 'I believe that the project will be a success. We worked well and we will work like that.'
- 'Positive development, I think.'
- 'I think that the project will be funny and useful to learn something more about our planet.'
- 'I think this project will be a success.'
- 'I think that the project will make positive development because we did a great job.'
- 'I am sure this project will make positive development.'
- 'Positive. If we work, we can improve the game and make it great.'
- 'Yes, positive development because we learn how to be more careful with our world from the game.'
- 'I am sure that the project will make a positive development and there will be no problems or threats.'
- 'I think that the project will make positive development because people can see what they do to our world and how hard it is to fix it.'
- 'I think that this project will make good changes in the world.'
- 'It may appear some minor problems, but nothing that can be solved. We did our best, so we expect good things.'
- 'There will be only positive developments.'
- 'I think that there will be only positive development because there is nothing negative in this project.'
- 'Positive development. There are no risks, threats and the game will surely improve.'
- 'Positive development due to our cooperation.'

**10. If there is anything else you want to express regarding the meeting in Moreni (things you really liked, things you did not like at all, things you missed, things that could be improved next time etc.)**

Most participants said that the meeting had been great, the people were nice and they really liked taking part in the activities. There was a student who said that he/she would have liked to spend less time at school and two other participants that would have liked more information about the politics and the economy of the partnership countries.

Some of the respondents' answers:

‘ I liked that I had something in common with the other abroad students.’  
‘ Everything went very well but in the future, the work to be done may be more precise.’  
‘I really liked the food’/’It was interesting.  
‘I really enjoyed the time spent all together and the Romanian team’s helpfulness’  
‘It was really interesting.’/‘ I really liked, really loved my time here in Moreni.’/’ Loved every single piece..’  
‘ I like the creation of the game.’  
‘I will miss my friends.’/’ It was great.’  
’The activities were nice and also the people.’.  
’I really liked how we spent a lot of time together during the activities at school and after they ended. We had lots of fun.’  
‘ We spent too much time at school..’  
’I would like to have more information about the economic and political system of these countries.’  
‘I do not want to express anything regarding the meeting in Moreni because everything was more than perfect, in my opinion.’  
‘The meeting was prepared well but I think there’s always room for better. I liked how we communicated and that was the key for making the game.’  
‘I wouldn’t change anything.’/ ‘It was awesome.’/’It was really nice’  
‘I want to say that I really liked it. It was very nice and I want to meet again with all the people that were here.’

Taking into account the participants’ answers and the results that we have obtained, it can be said that the project meeting held in Moreni achieved its objectives.
