





According to what families have answered in this survey, we can say that:



85.7% of families think that project based learning is better than traditional learning because students get more motivated and they improve their skills however 14.3% of families think that students learn less contents through project based learning.




92.9% of families think that this project has helped students improve their digital competence, however, 7.1% of families think that it has been difficult for them.




35.7% of families think that thanks to this project children have improved digital skills.

21% of families think that they have improved social and civic skills.


- 14.3% of families think that they are more autonomous.
- 14.3% of families think that they are more entrepreneur.






