Always follow simple internet rules as this can lead to a positive digital footprint.



# How to Manage Your Digital Footprint

You may want to use a VPN so your IP and data are encrypted and are less likely to be stolen or misused.

Turn on your Social Media Privacy settings: make your account private.

Examine your own digital footprint and see how much somebody could find out about you, your family and friends from your accounts.

Always ask for permission  
from the owner if you  
would like to use somebody  
else's ideas, comment,  
work or pictures.



# How to Use content on the internet shared by others

Using other people's words as yours is not honest and can be offensive. You wouldn't like it to be done to yourself.

Be respectful with the content published by other people on social networks, everyone is free to publish their opinions or ideas.

Always remember that there are real people implicated, so you can put people at risk if your systems are not secure and the data you're using falls into the wrong hands.



# How to Maintain Safe Online Relationships

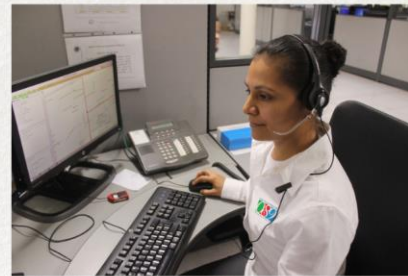
You mustn't share pictures of you with people you don't actually trust. That can be really dangerous.

To be safe while chatting online with friends, make sure you don't share information that is too personal.

If someone persistently asks for personal details, don't give any more information and block as soon as possible and ask for help.





# How to Maintain Safe Online Relationships

Do not accept to meet someone you met on the internet in person as it can be very dangerous. .



You can never be sure about the truthfulness of the information you have about them. Try to verify anything that you come across on the net.



# How to **Maintain Safe Online Relationships**



.Stop talking to a person if you feel uncomfortable with his/her action.

Follow your gut. If someone seems suspicious and asks too many questions stop talking to them.



Don't wait too long to figure out who your online friend really is.

If you would like to continue chatting with them, you need to do a background search.
