[&]quot;We want to meet three times for **three working days**; there will be two participants from each sending organization: the leader of the project with one teachers or staff from the school according to the needs of the project each time.

We would like to have a first meeting in Corsica in order to organize training courses to start the project according to quality standards; Brigitte Collomb being an eTwinning ambassador, Quality Label evaluator and trainer.

We want to make sure all the participants are able to use the TwinSpace functionalities as

well as the basic collaborative tools we use in projects; we want to use the TwinSpace all along the project and ask for eTwinning quality labels every year. It's important for the participants to be able to manage the project planification, communication, documentation: taking pictures, shooting videos and opening a YouTube channel in order to document the activities; then we will train the participant so that each can be able to do his required assigned tasks in the project like for example: share the projects results according to the right targets; advertise those results and measure their impact thanks to surveys at different levels: local, national and European; We need all the participants to be able to understand the project strategies shared and how these strategies and activities can impact their organization, town, region and Europe. The Polish teacher will explain impact measurement and dissemination plan. We will have training courses on our first creativity techniques. We will have a training course with an artistic association to focus on team spirit building, creativity and culture, and we will meet some of our external partners in France, artists, Creative fablab, museums... We will finish measuring the impact of the training session (satisfaction and skills gained) according to the participants learning plan; we will disseminate our meeting outcomes and results."

- 5. Our communication between the partners should be essential: we need to communicate to make the project a success; for example, on our WhatsApp group. We must be ready to ask for help, or to explain our difficulties.
- 6. We must have a project netiquette for the teachers and the students.
- 7. It's important to respect our planification and to create the products declared on the application.
- 8. Everybody has to join the TwinSpace; the pages will soon be ready for the teachers to start working on.
- 9. We will have a visio in August to get started! But each school can ask for a visio if needed with the project coordinator.
- 10. There are no problems concerning covid for the moment to travel between our countries.
