Erasmus+ (2014-2020) is an inclusive and prospective European Programme for Education

Build your European inclusive project:

- Download the Application on your Erasmus+ National Agency's website
- Search your European partners thanks to the eTwinning platform
- Choose with your partners topic, aims and activities focusing on European inclusion
- Identify in this area the needs and experiences in your school
- Plan the mobility: Type and number. Topic, activities, outcomes and evaluation
- Build your delegation composed by
 - Mainstream students and staff
 - Special Educational Needs (S.E.N.) students and their accompanying persons
- Build your budget :
 - according to the profile of the participants
 - fixed allocation for mainstream students and staff
 - real eligible costs for S.E.N. students and accompanying persons (special request)

Implement your 2 or 3 year project Step by step:

- Organize in your school the work before, during and after each mobility
- Communicate and cooperate with your European partners
- Select carefully the students and staff to be involved. Ask medical and special teams.
- Keep all your pedagogical outcomes as well as administrative and financial documents
- Plan in the Application and managed during the project's life: Evaluation- Dissemination- Impact
- Respect the Grant agreement signed with your Erasmus+ National Agency conditions, dates and steps
