- doing different new things

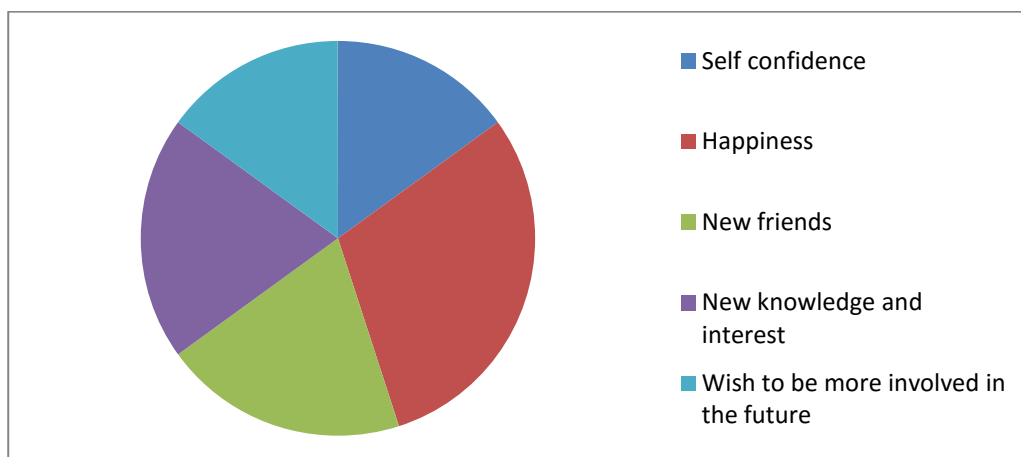
Students felt that:
