- making new friends

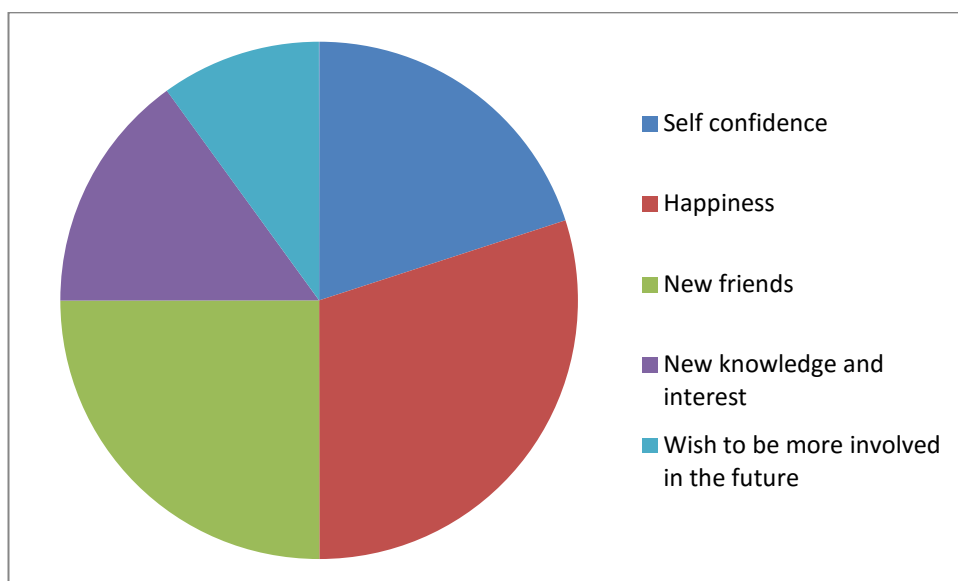
### Students felt that:
