Students felt that:

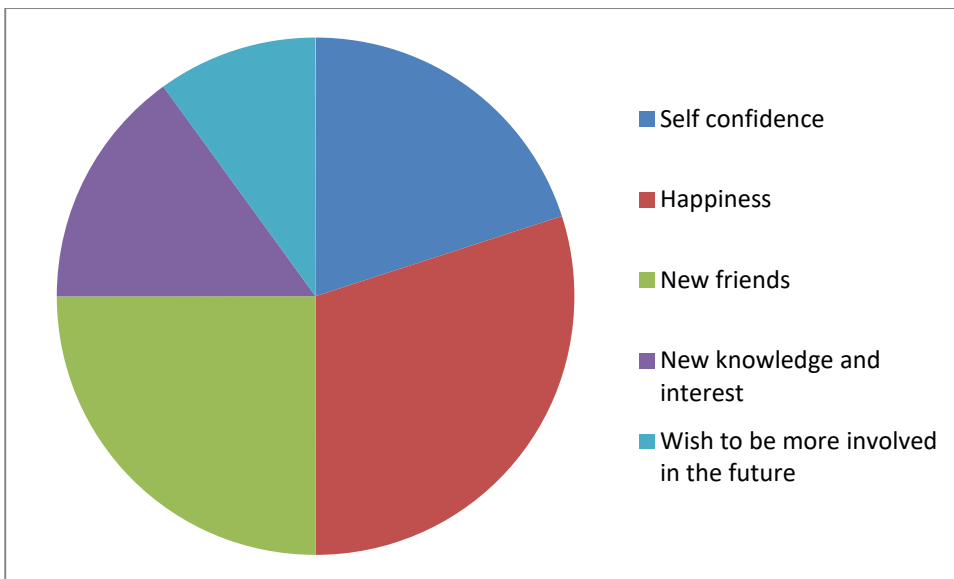
- communication was better now infact they interacted with students and teachers without any problems because more selfconfident
