### <u>Christmas symbols ir</u> Bulgaria.

The Christmas tree is among the most common traditions associated with the celebration of Christmas. It is an ornament of an evergreen coniferous tree - most often of the genus fir, whence the name. Before Christmas, the tree is cut down, brought into the home and decorated with colorful lights, ornaments and treats. In some cases, large street trees are decorated in strategic places without being cut down. Also, in some cases, artificial trees are used instead of living ones.
