- The main and invariable part of the filling is the rice. In addition, vegetables (onions or leeks, carrots, celery, tomatoes or tomato paste), meat (lamb, pork, beef or fish), spices to taste or aroma (sweet or hot red pepper) can be added to it in different national varieties. , black pepper, cumin, dill),

Christmas recipe for a banitsa with good luck



- Beat the eggs, add the yogurt, soda and grated cheese. Arrange the crust and apply the filling evenly, putting oil here and there on each crust, leaving some of the mixture to spread on the last crust. When we have ordered the last crust, cut the pie and spread with the rest of the mixture. Bake at 200C for about 25-30 minutes. I used toothpicks to order my luck.

Christmas symbols



- The main Christmas colors are red and green and this is no accident. The green color symbolizes hope, growth and life as a whole, and the red color symbolizes the self-sacrifice of Christ and the shed blood.

Carolers



- Christmas is one of the traditional Bulgarian customs, characterized by festive attire, decorated hats and carols. A winter custom in which the carolers go around people's homes and sing ritual songs with different motives, and the owners of the house give them money, bacon, beans, wine and so on.
