Tenthousands of people came to an anti-racism concert in Chemnitz which aims to drown out recent far-rights and violence in the eastern German city.



# Sunday

By Sunday afternoon, around 800 people had gathered to protest the man's death, including far-right groups. Authorities said that the crowd was uncooperative and threw bottles at police officers. The mobilization were spontaneous and have surfaced following calls to demonstrate on social media.

# Monday

On Monday, thousands of people gathered at the heart of Chemnitz. Police, who said about 6000 people came there. They managed to keep the opposing sides apart until 9 pm, when the situation began to escalate. Protestors threw fireworks, bottles and other projectiles. The 600-strong police force brought in two water cannon as a deterrent. several far-right protesters performed Nazi salute.
