city is Bucharest.

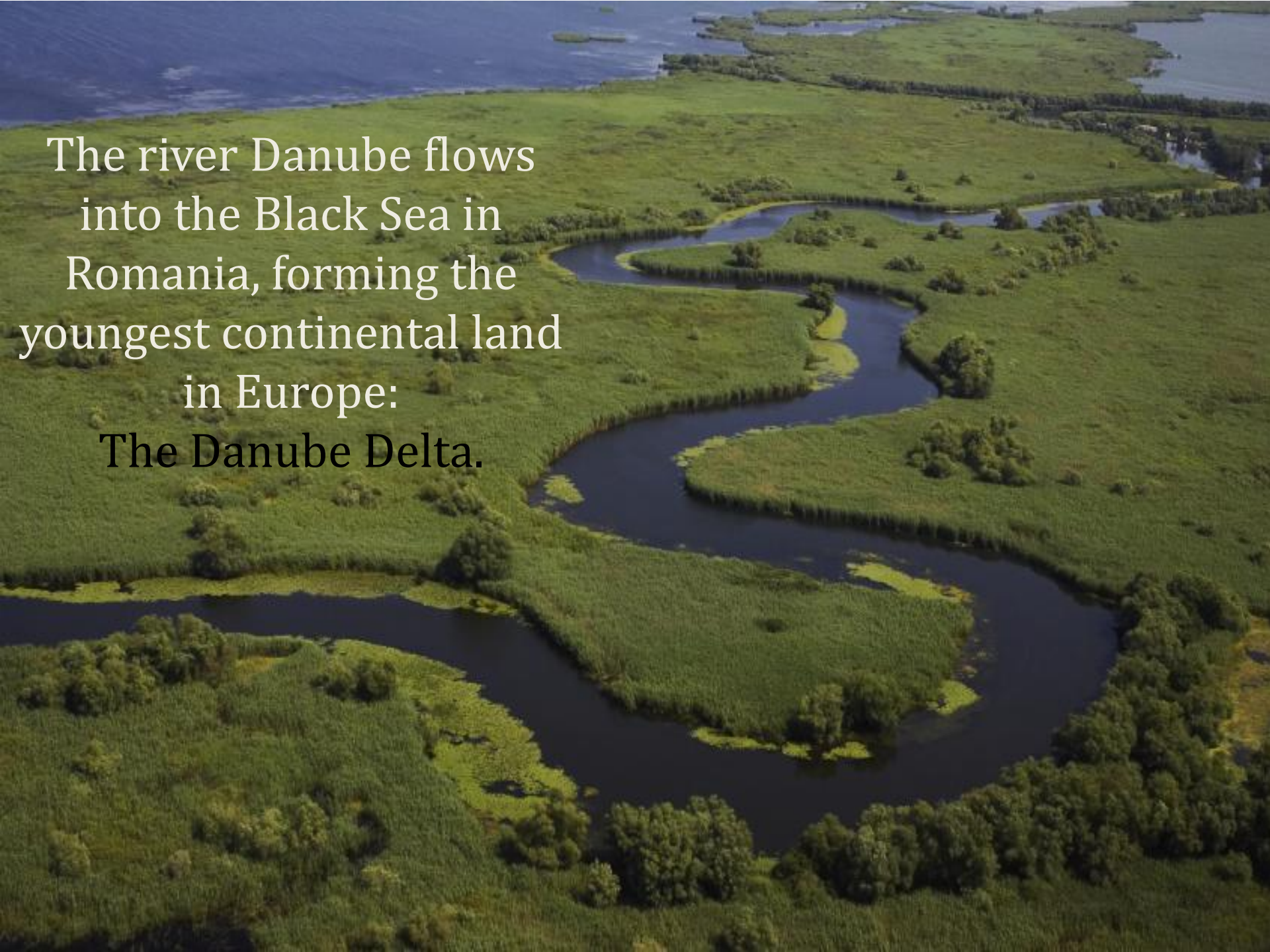


The **Palace of the Parliament** is the second largest building in the world.
