  - Collect items for an exhibition: newspaper clips, books etc. and find a way to present them
- Each country will conduct research on online comments (social media entries) on migration (xenophobic vs empathic comments) and prepare a presentation
- In each national group, there has to be a discussion about the responsibility and accountability
  of social networks (generalized conclusions based on our topic) and combine the results of
  their discussion in a written document which the students should use in the international
  group discussion in Greece
- Catalina reminded us to collect all students' activities conducted at each TTLA for the handbook that we need to assemble at the end of the project
- Facebook video meeting (teachers only) scheduled for March 2<sup>nd</sup> at 2 pm Azorean time (Ilidia will start the call)
