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## Young people and urban citizenship – Students managing photo and video projects on urban chances and challenges

### *How to create a virtual city tour*

#### **Your task**

Create a virtual city tour taking your European fellow students to places of your town or a nearby town which are of interest to young people.

- **Choose 3-5 places you want to include in your tour**, e.g. the trendiest café to hang out and meet friends, the most exotic restaurant, the best library to do research, the best place to study for exams, the most fashionable shop to find extraordinary clothes, a must-see tourist sight (including fun facts).
- **Do research** on your chosen places and **produce a short film (not longer than 2 minutes) on each of these spots**, presenting the place and providing relevant information.

#### *Ideas for the research*

- name and nature of the place (bar, cafe, etc. etc.),
- its founders / owners,
- since when the place has been in operation,
- why young people go there in the first place.

In your short film include **one interview** of a young customer / visitor, asking the question "Could you please tell who you are and what is it about this place that you find appealing?".

Every video needs to contain both **audio and / or short captions in English** providing information on the things listed above.

- **Hold a video conference** with students from our partner schools during which you will **act as tour guides – live!** You will be expected to greet “the virtual tourists”, introduce yourself, briefly introduce the town you are virtually guiding “the tourists” through, give an overview of the tour, explain where you will take “the tourists”, **present the films you have produced**, answer questions etc.
