(You can upload the pictures in the evening, too, if it's not possible to do so right away.) **Have fun!**

Starting point: Bahnhofsvorplatz (square in front of the train station)

Photo task A: Take a funny photo of your group in front of the **I love Fulda** logo.

Photo task B: Take a photo of your group with the **flag of the European Union** (tip: you can find one at the entrance to one of the most famous baroque buildings in Fulda).

Photo task C: Bridges symbolise travel, a new beginning and unity, and are a meeting point between people who live in different locations. Take a photo of your group **on a bridge**.

Photo task D: Take a photo **with the famous saint and immigrant who founded the monastery in Fulda and is buried in Fulda cathedral** (tip: his name starts with a B).
