Cold war museum



Target group: students aged 16-17

Number of participants: 17

Type of activity: lesson-excursion

Duration of the activity: 60 minutes

Main objective: while visiting Cold war museum, to find out the reasons of Cold war and form vision about geopolitical situation in the world after the World War II.

Location: Zemaitija national park, Cold war museum

Pedagogical methods used: excursion, discussion

Necessary materials: a camera, a notebook, a pen

Detailed content of the activity:

Step 1. During the history lesson, students learn about Cold war.

Step 2. Students go to Cold war museum where while listening to the guide find out the reasons of Cold war. Students have to explain why the period from 1945 till the beginning of the last decade is named Cold war. Students name and describe the main periods and consequences of Cold war.

Step 3. Students take some photos of the exhibits.
