

ERASMUS+ "Little steps make a big difference. Together, we care for our home"



The European Erasmus + "Little steps make a big difference. Together, we care for our home" programme, aims to transform the 6 European schools involved in the partnership into sustainable schools in the ecological, social and economic field of cooperation. Pupils from 6 countries, Poland, Slovakia, Greece, Spain, Turkey and Romania, (partners) will be at the centre of attention as part of the project's activities. The teachers will work on specific tasks in order to transform each school into a viable space for all participants and the school society in ecological, social and economic level. In cooperation with the National Centre for Ecological activity in each partner country, we will act to obtain certificates, which are awarded to schools that specifically encourage the social activity of residents, give examples of good and action and create an active educational environment for young people. The first stage of certification of international standards will be the awarding of schools with the certificate "Green Flag". The "Green Flag" is an international qualification that is awarded to schools all over the world under the Eco-Schools programme, which brings together more than 15,000 schools from 58 countries around the world as a recognition of the measures that have been taken to create an environmentally friendly school. The programme encourages and permits international cooperation. More specifically, a set of educational, pedagogical and experiential activities is developed by the Pedagogical and environmental group of our school for each partner school within two the two year time during which this partnership will be implemented. Working in a multilateral group, we seek to increase motivation, the desire to achieve pro-ecological actions, to broaden the scope of business in relation to ecology and thus to influence and change the lives of EU citizens for the better. In this program we will work to make students and educators aware of their potential to take individual and collective actions in their area-to make them more ecologically and socially comfortable places to inhabit. For this reason we aim to organise workshops in which students will be the main coordinators. They will be able to work and implement their own ideas. Cooperation with the programmes will lead to the development of social and linguistic competences and will be a valuable experience in the use of ICT in education, skills that will be useful for the preparation and better future of the students participating in the programme. The sustainability that is the main theme of this project is also an important aspect of our cooperation. Trained ecology educators from all countries in this partnership will be moved to other partner countries. Cooperation in a European dimension within the European Union will be the most important part of this partnership-the experience that all participants will personally experience. In addition, students will be trained to undertake and develop specific project plans and to implement concrete results, gaining experience that will improve the conditions of mutual cooperation, promote respect, sense of tolerance and a better understanding between them.
