### C3: Meeting, carried out in

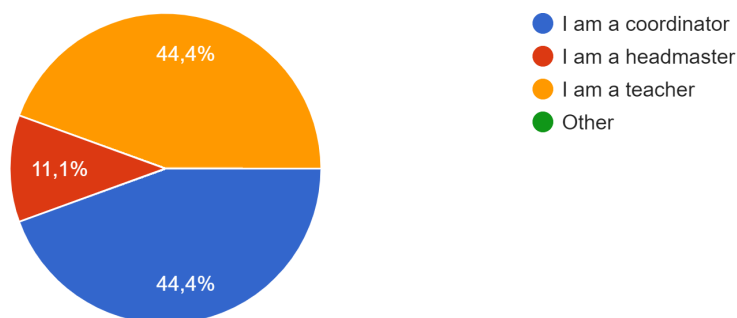
Participants in the meeting: 11 people (excluding the host country). 5 coordinators, 1 headmaster and 5 teachers

#### 1. What is your current position ?

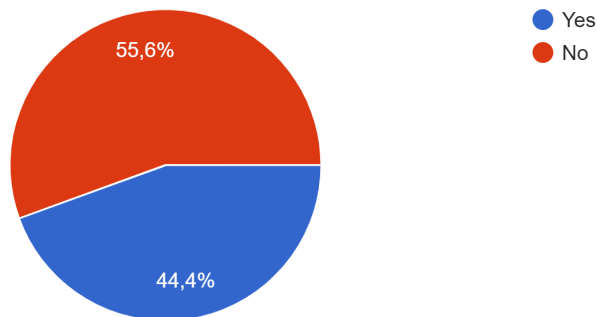

## 2. Was this the first time you participated in an international mobility program?

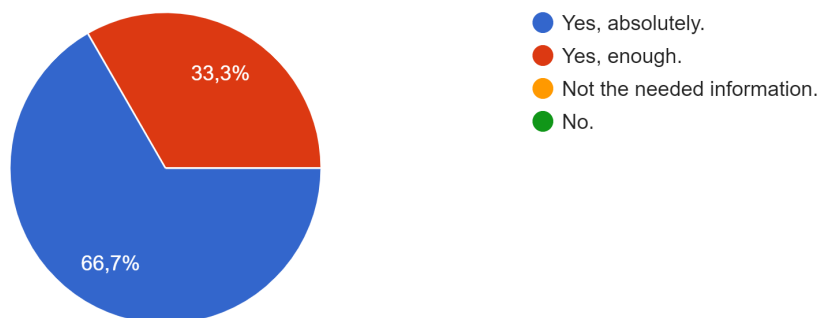

## 3. Did you receive enough information from the host country about the best option to travel from the origin country till the final destination?

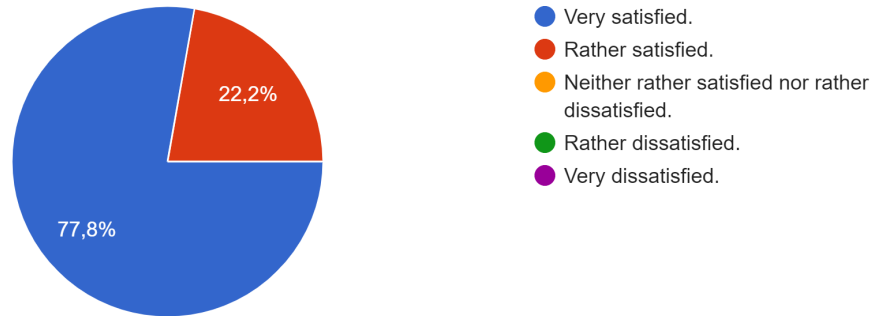

#### 4. How satisfied are you with your accommodation arrangements?

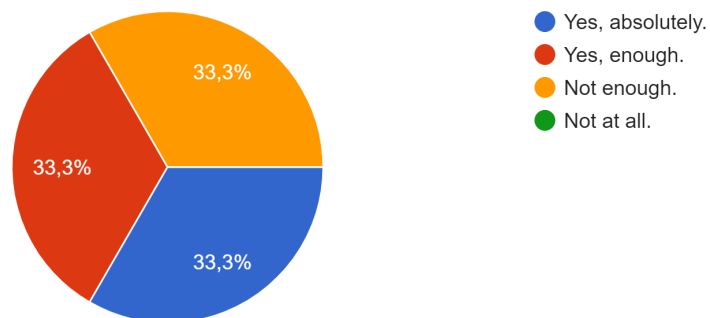

#### 5. Did you get enough information to develop the required tasks previous to the meeting?

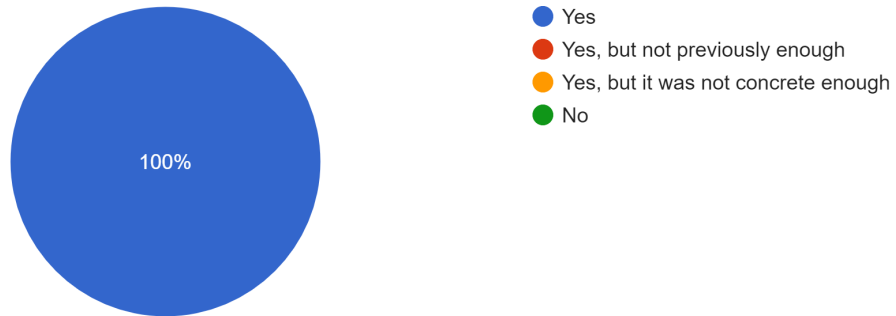

## 6. Did you receive previously the Meeting Plan?

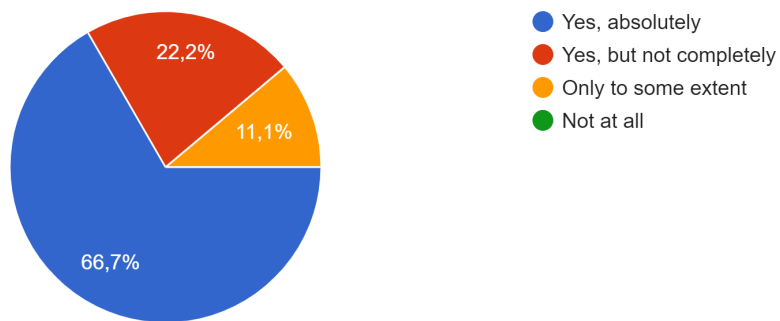

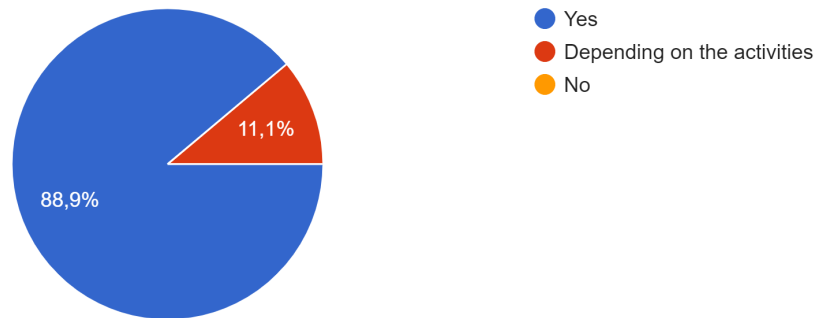

### 8. Has English been the main used language to communicate during the meeting?

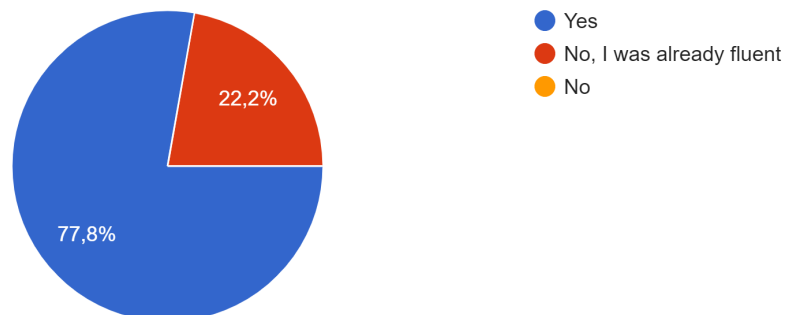

### 9. Do you feel you have improved your skills in this language during the meeting?

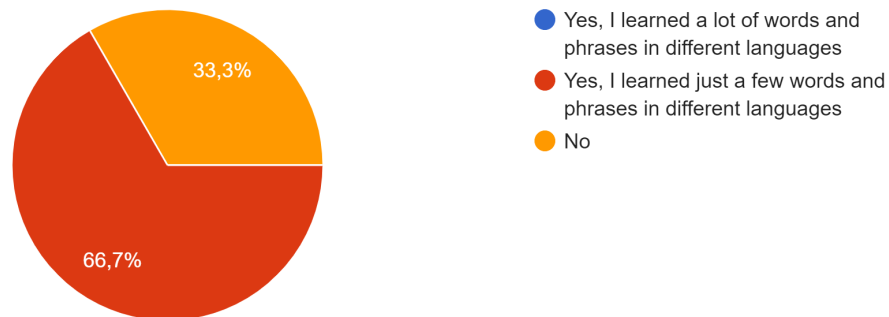

All considers that they improved their skills in English, but 2 of them consider that he/she was already fluent.

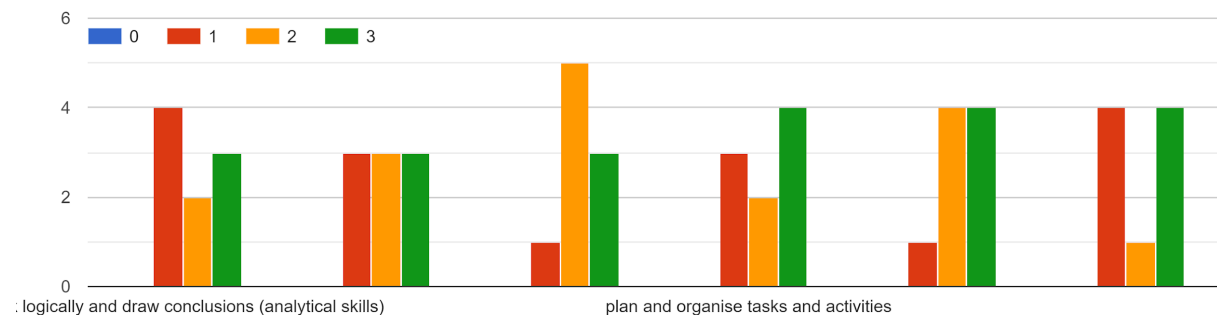
## 10. While participating in the meeting, did you improve your competence in other languages besides the main one used?

## 11. Through my participation in this mobility activity I learned better how to... (0-nothing....3-a lot)

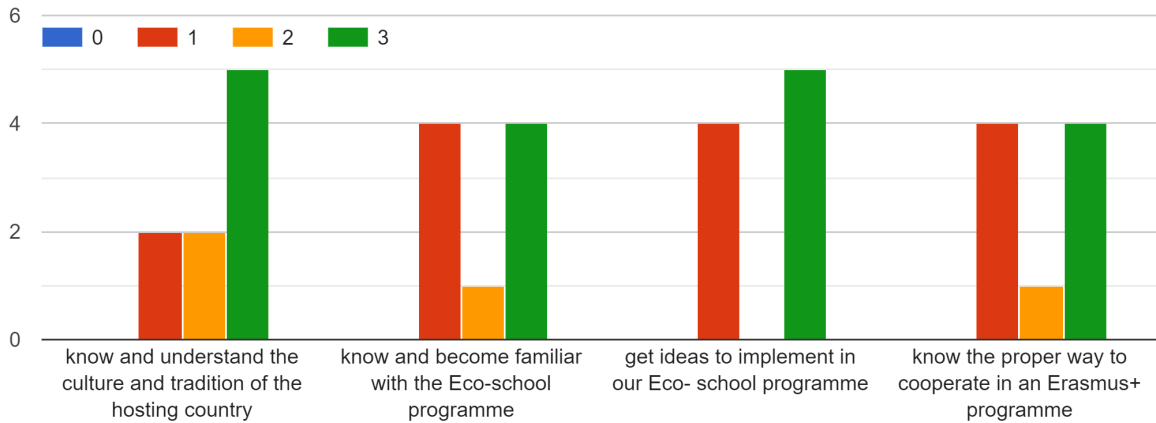


According to the graphic, we deduce that:

- 1.-think logically and draw conclusions (analytical skills). 5 of the nine participants consider that it served quite or a lot.
- 2.-find solutions in difficult or challenging contexts (problem- solving skills). 6 of the nine participants consider that it served quite or a lot.
- 3.- communicate and express myself in foreign languages. Only one participant consider that it served little
- 4.- plan and organise tasks and activities. 6 of the nine participants consider that it served quite or a lot.
- 5.- communicate with people from different countries and cultures. Only one participant consider that it served little

6.- cooperate in teams (listen to others' opinions, respect them and add your point of view to improve the quality of the common project). 6 of the nine participants consider that it served quite or a lot.

### 12. Participating in the meeting has allowed me to... (0-nothing....3-a lot)

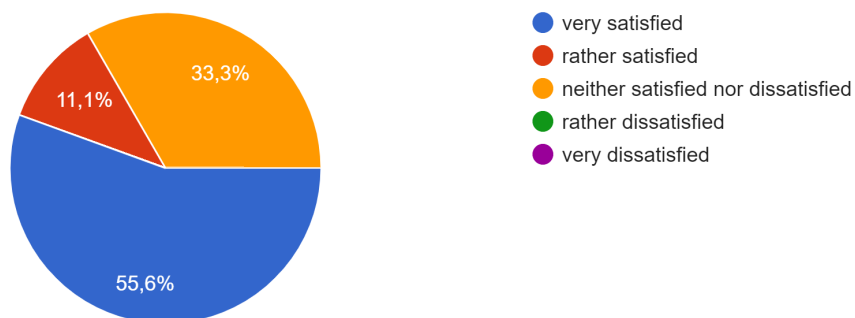


According to the graphics we deduce that participating in the meeting:

- 1.- Helped the majority of the participants to know and understand the culture and tradition of the hosting country (Greece)

- 3.- To 5 of the 9 participants contributed a lot to get ideas to implement in their Eco- school programme. The other participants think it has contributed little
- 4.- To 5 of the 9 participants helped to know the proper way to cooperate in an Erasmus+ programme

### 13. How satisfied were you with the way the host partner dealt with any questions, complaints or problems that... your participation in the programme?

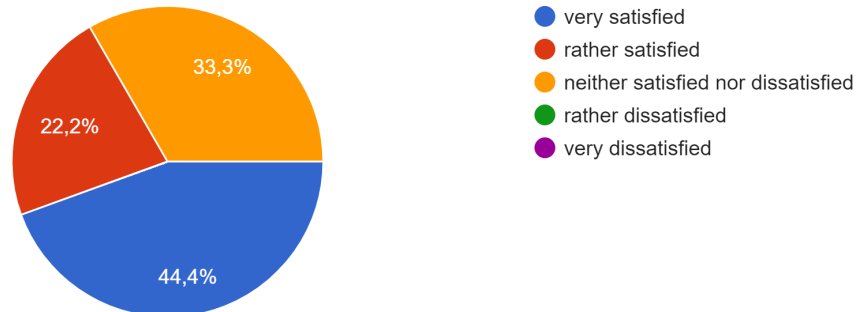
