5. Do you collect rainwater for watering plants?	Rainwater is not collected for watering the plants	
6. Do you know how water is cleaned before we drink it?	34% answered YES	
7. Do you know about the water cycle?		79% answered YES
8. Have you learned about sources of water pollution?	45% answered NO	55% answered YES
9. Do you know why it is important to save water even in a country with		61% answered YES

10. Do you know that people have unequal access to clean water around the world?	71% answered YES
