C2: Meeting, carried out in

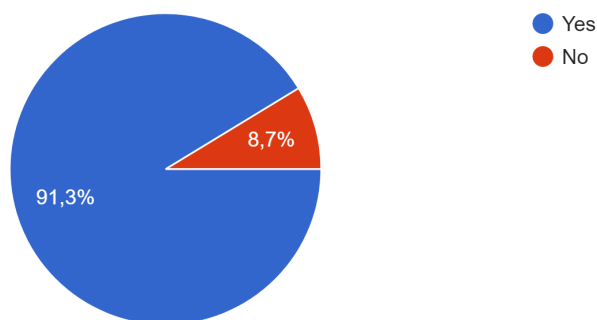
20 students participated in the meeting. Besides, there were the Slovak students, from the host team, who didn't have to answer the questionnaire.

23 responses

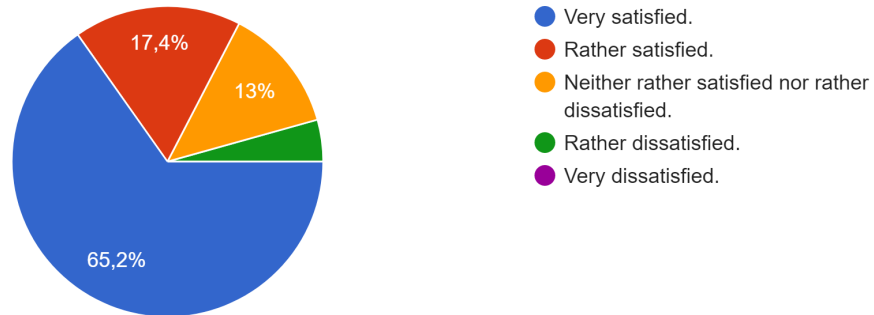


The 91,3% of students participated for the first time in an international mobility. Only 2

2. How satisfied are you with your accommodation arrangements?

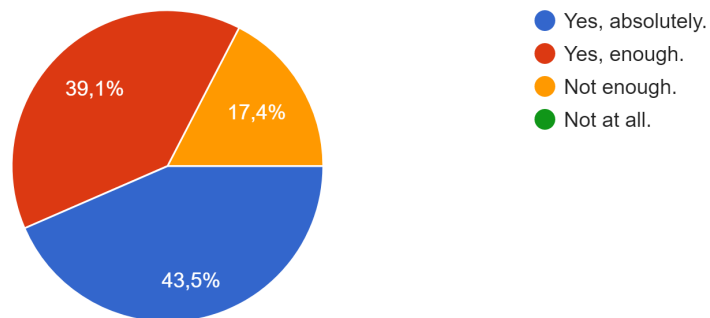
23 responses

3. Did you get enough information to develop the required tasks previous to the meeting?

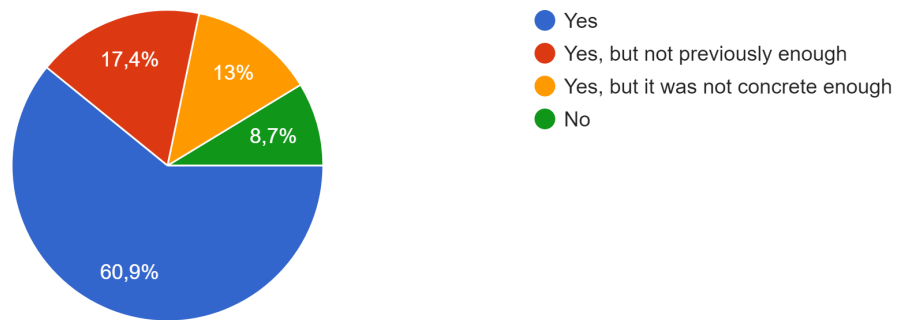
23 responses

4. Did you receive previously the Meeting Plan?

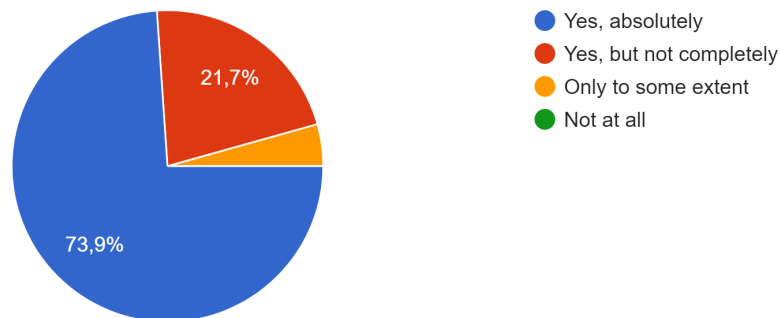
23 responses

5. Do you believe the planned activities have been useful to work on the topic of the water saving?

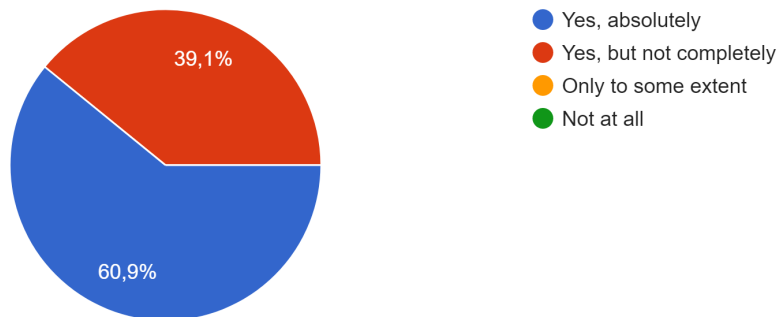
23 responses

6. Do you believe the planned activities outside the school have been helpful to work the water saving topic?

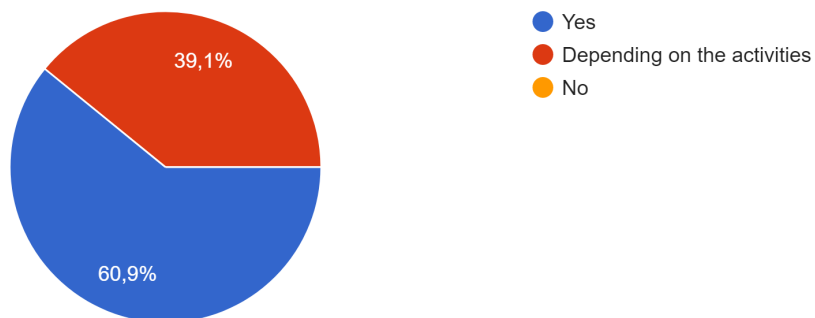
23 responses

7. Has English been the main used language to communicate during the meeting?

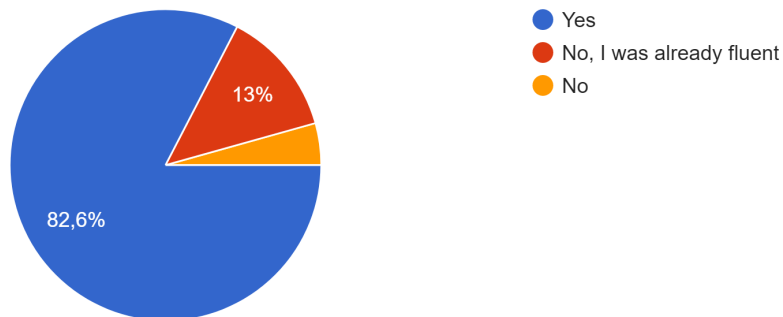
23 responses

8. Do you feel you have improved your skills in this language during the meeting?

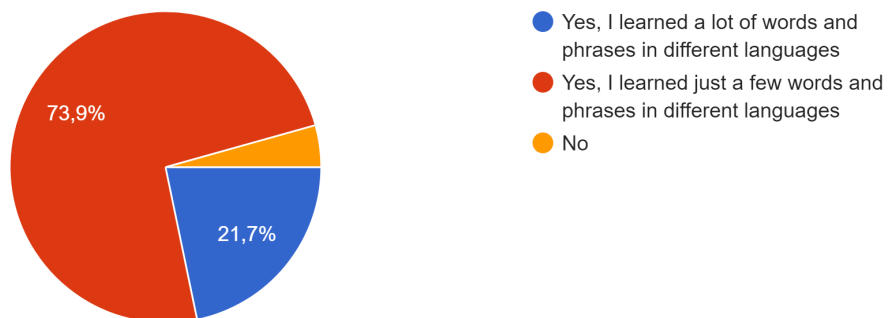
23 responses

9. While participating in the meeting, did you improve your competence in other languages besides the main one used?

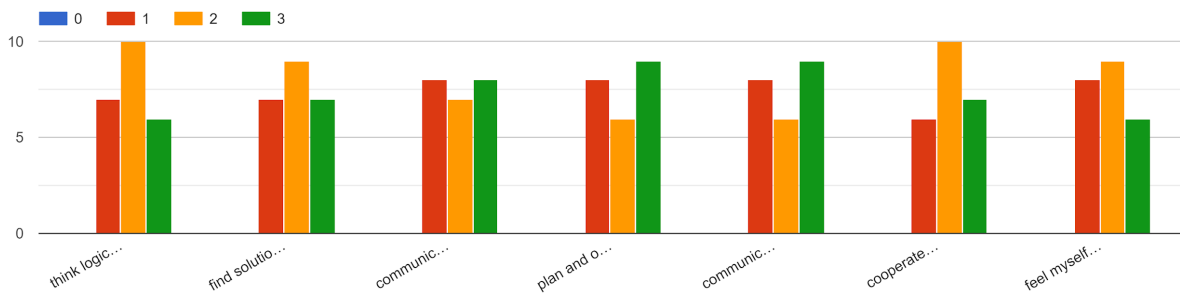
23 responses

Only one student considers that he/she didn't learn any words.

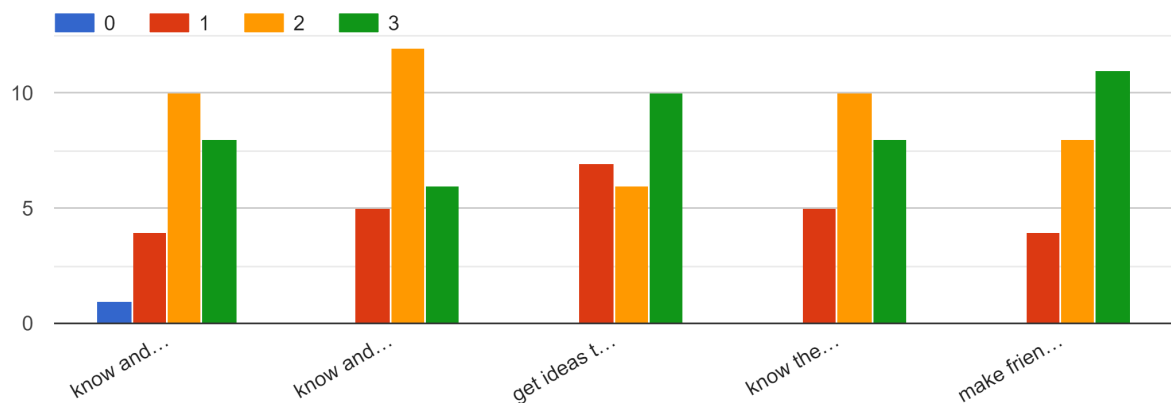
10. Through my participation in this mobility activity I learned better how to... (0-nothing...3-a lot)

11. Participating in the meeting has allowed me to...(0-nothing...3-a lot)

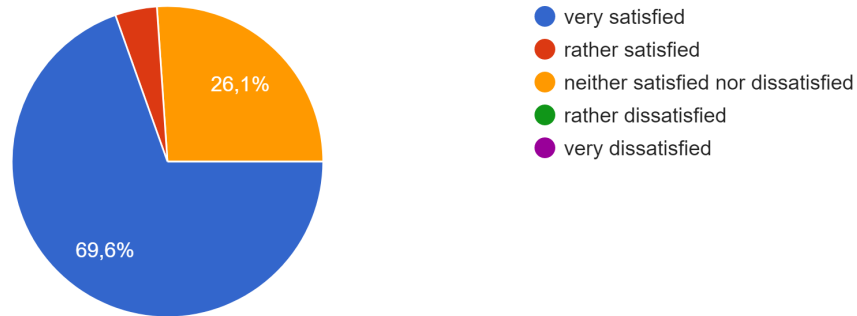


According to the graphics we deduce that:
