


## The First Transnational Meeting

## 1. Preparation for the meeting




It was pretty well-organised.

- Nothing particular.


#### 5. What would you like to suggest for further meetings?

- More free time.


#### 6. What were your expectations for this meeting and how well were they met? 8 responses
