
#### 1. INTRODUCTION

The mid-term survey intended to evaluate parents' opinions regarding the impact of Hands On CLIL project in their sibblings learning paths during the first year of the project's implementation. The survey was answered by 73 parents from the schools involved in the partnership: Portugal, Slovakia, Spain and Turkey.

#### 2. DATA ANALYSIS

#### 2.1 Data Summary for PARENTS

Among the parents that participated in the questionnaire and to the question – What was the impact of Hands On CLIL project on your son/ daughter's school learning experience?, they highlighted (1) 'It helped my son/ daughter become more confident with foreign language use' with 53% of the respondants referring 'strongly agree' and 44% 'agree'; (2) 'It helped to improve my son/ daughter foreign language communication and proficiency' with 49% of the respondants referring 'strongly agree'; and (3) 'It fostered collaborative work' with 45% of the respondants referring 'strongly agree'.







With reference to the question **How important was Hands On CLIL in the cultural and social dimension?,** parents stated 'It improved the knowledge about different countries and cultures' with 49% of the parents saying 'strongly agree' and 47% saying 'agree'.

# How important was Hands On CLIL in the cultural and social dimension?




When asked 'How important were the following Hands On CLIL activities for your son/ daughter's bilingual school learning experience?', parents chose 'very important' and 'important' to the follow: (1) 93,94% for 'songs'; (2) 92,54% for 'games'; and (3) '90,14% for the 'Science Modules'.





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






As far as **problems encountered during the first year of project implementation**, parents mentioned 'It was hard learning other school subjects in English' with 13% saying 'often' and 4% saying 'always' and 'The language of the materials were too difficult' with 11% saying 'often' and 3% stating 'always'. Nevertheless, it is safe to say that parents didn't consider that pupils faced major problems during the first year of project's implementation.
